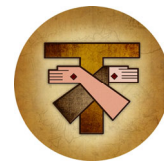

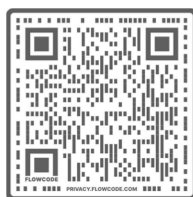

Our Successful MissionFest 2024

The weekend of April 27-28 started out in auspiciously with a very windy Saturday and a heavy rain on Sunday morning. Because of the rain Mass was moved into the church. However, God smiled on us. Rather quickly the rain stopped and the sun came out, making for a beautiful and enjoyable day. We counted approximately 5,000 attendants visiting our parish and park grounds. Wow!

Among those visitors were the leaders of Fiesta San Antonio. They were most impressed with our organization, the layout and the positive atmosphere at the festival. As a result, we have been granted full membership in Fiesta San Antonio. This means that we will have better advertising and the possibility of grants to help us in the future. We are proud of this achievement and look forward to continuing the great tradition of the Fiesta and our parish.

Also we were blessed with many volunteers from outside the parish. Chief among them were representatives of Jefferson Bank who helped us with credit card machines, and employees of Target who helped staff booths throughout the day.

Here is a breakdown of our income and expense for MissionFest:

Income: approximately \$110,000.00

This includes generous donations from sponsors, entrance gate and outside vendor fees, among other things.

Expenses: approximately \$82,000.00

This includes purchase of food for booths, fees for musical entertainment, fees to the city and the purchase of necessary supplies for the day.

Net Income: approximately \$45,000.00

So many parishioners contributed to the success of the day. We are thankful – whether you spent the day working in a booth, cleaning up the grounds, spent time counting money and tickets, or were among the many attendees. As Fr. Herb said in the past, the success of Missionfest is primarily in the building up of community. Our community was visible throughout the day!

Of course, MissionFest doesn't happen on its own. Thanks to all who planned under the leadership of Jesse Garcia, the Core Committee, the booth managers and workers. We can't do this without you. Here's to celebration of this year's festival and to many more in the future.
