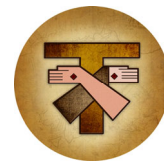

Take nothing but a walking stick...

What a challenge today's Gospel is! I can't imagine what went through the minds and hearts of the disciples as Jesus sent them off. First of all, they are used to following along with Jesus, but here he sends them off, two by two, all by themselves. No doubt there was some fear. "Would we be able to preach with the power of Jesus? Would we even know what to say? And what about healing? If we're to be Jesus' presence as we go forth can we do what he has done? Do we have the same connection with the Father as Jesus does?" My stomach churns just thinking about it.

But that's not all. The conditions he places on them mean they will have to rely completely on the kindness of strangers. Don't take any food with you. Don't carry a sack with those daily needs in it. Don't even carry any money in your belt to buy things. Wow! You can wear sandals in order to protect your feet from the heat of the roads, but don't take a second tunic. I'll bet they were ripe by the time they returned. Why? Why does Jesus tell them this? By setting out in this way, they must trust in God, rely upon God's benevolence exercised through strangers. These circumstances give new meaning to a song we often sing: "Only in God will my soul be at rest."

The disciples had several big decisions in following Jesus. First of all, listening to his words of invitation and deciding to follow. Second, re-committing every time he said something either strangely new or wonderfully revelatory. Third, saying yes to his sending them out and trusting that all would be taken care of. As a result of their decision-making and their trust in Jesus, great things happened. They drove out many demons and anointed people to heal them. Imagine what it was like when they returned to Jesus with their stories. It was worth it!

Every morning when we friars pray together I try to make the same commitment. To trust more and more in God. To go through my day trying to bring the peace of Jesus to people I meet. To recognize how magnificent God is when I look on the beauty of nature around us. Yes, there are times of doubt and fear, they are part of this journey of faith. But over all, it is worth it!

I pray we can all take up this journey of faith. God invites you to follow, and God sends you out to share your experience of God. May God keep us, protect us and encourage us. Peace and all good!

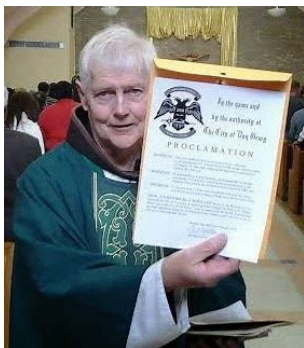
