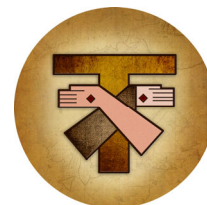

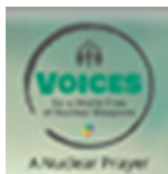

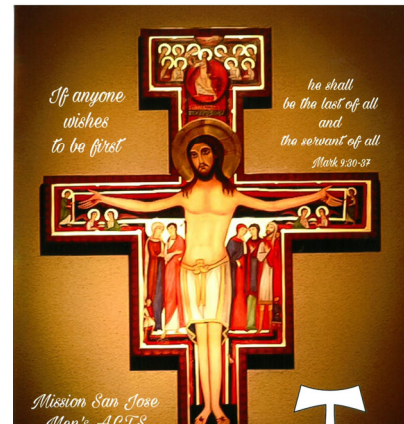


**Prayer in Honour of the Assumption

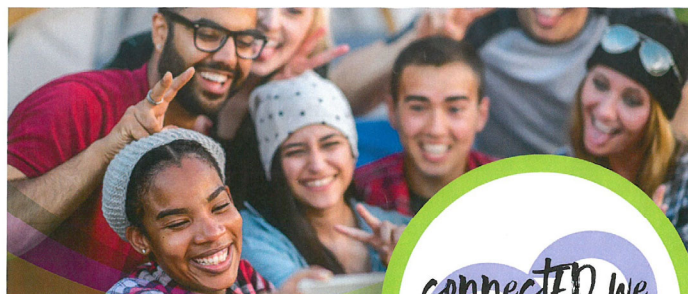

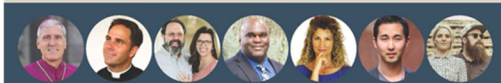
