Catholic Funeral Rites Part 1

"At the death of a Christian, whose life of faith was begun in the waters of Baptism and strengthened at the Eucharistic table, the Church intercedes on behalf of the deceased because of its confident belief that death is not the end, nor does it break the bonds forged in life. The Church also ministers to the sorrowing and consoles them in the funeral rites with the comforting Word of God and the Sacrament of the Eucharist." From Order of Christian Funerals

The Catholic funeral rite is divided into several stations, or parts, each with its own purpose. For this reason we recommend following the complete structure and making use of each station.

- + ***Vigil Service (Wake)***
- + ***Funeral Liturgy***
- + ***Rite of Committal (Burial or Interment)***

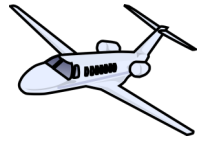

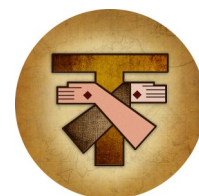

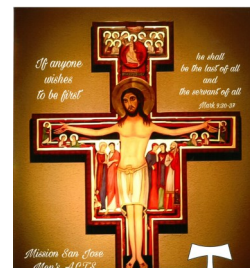
