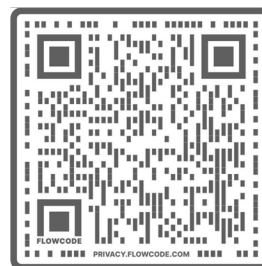
WELCOME TO MISSION SAN JOSE CATHOLIC CHURCH

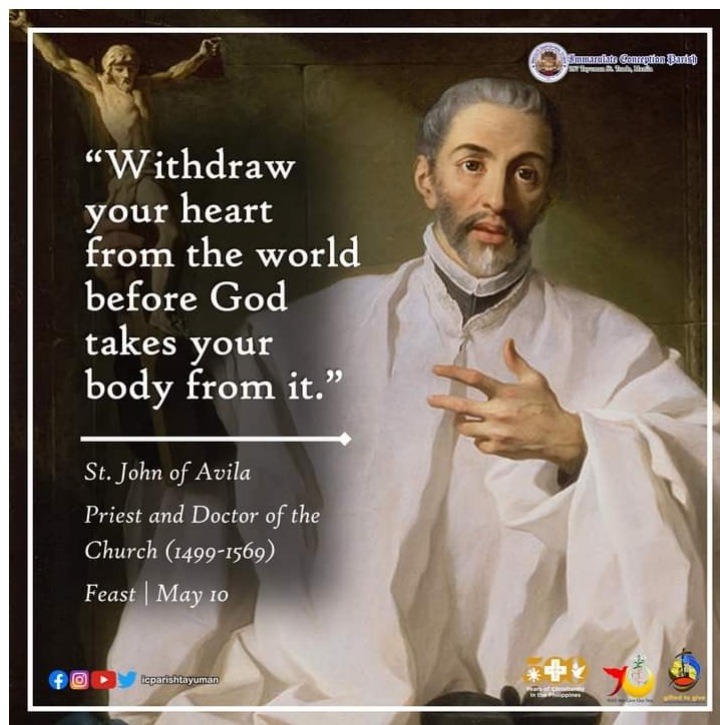

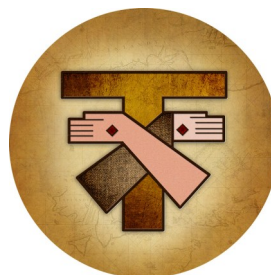
