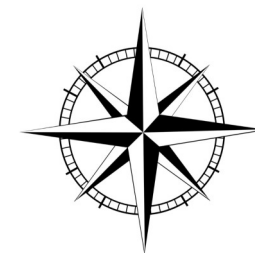

CELEBRATING 85 YEARS AT SMU
