Last Thursday, SMU biological studies graduate student and SMU Catholic 2016 Servant Leadership Award winner Collette LaVigne represented SMU Catholic at a Pro-Life/Pro-Choice Discussion Panel hosted by SMU Feminists Equality Movement (SMUFEM).
