Swing by the Catholic Center this week see some of the final artwork!

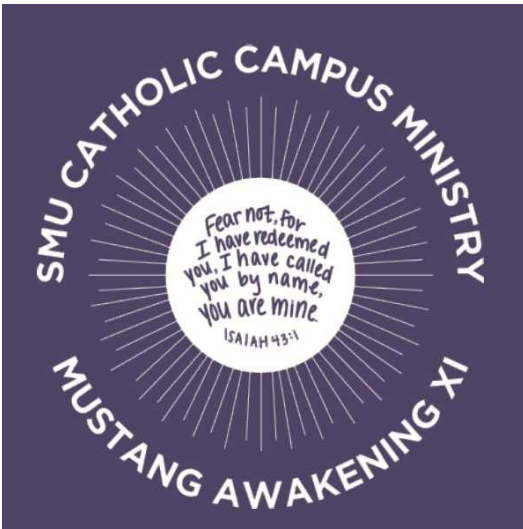
COMMUNITY EDUCATION

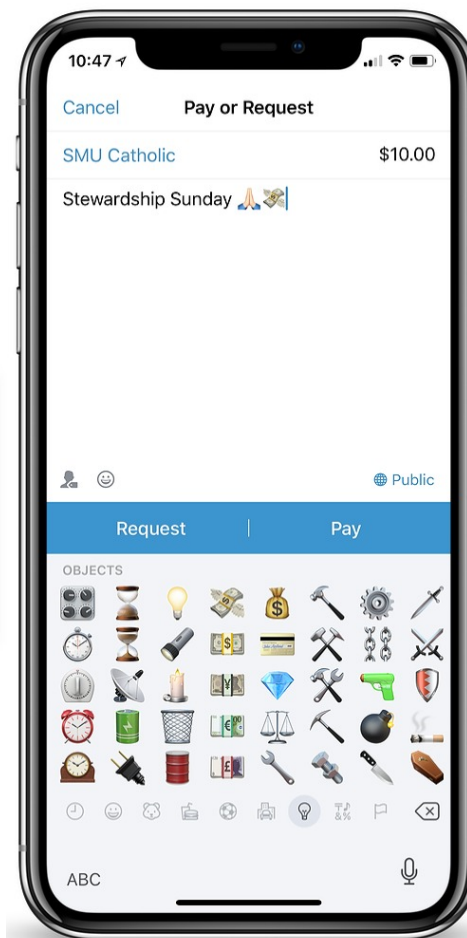
### URBAN PLUNGE Mexico City
