SERVANT LEADER AWARDS RECIPIANTS FOR SPRING CELEBRATION 2019

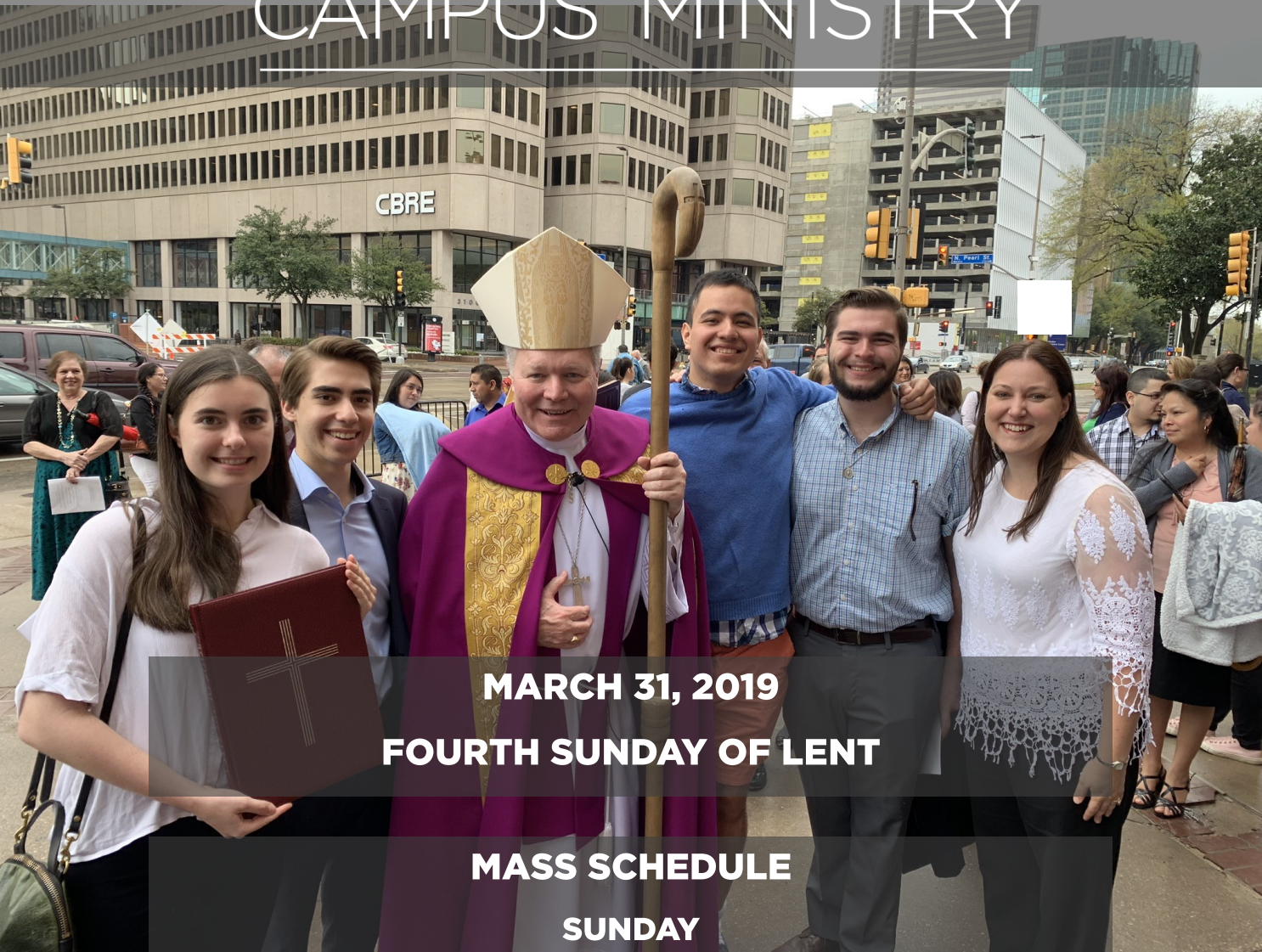
