### SHERI MOONEY AWARD RECIPIENT : SMYTHE MULLIKIN

Smythe Mullikin '19 was awarded the Sheri Mooney Memorial Recognition at the annual Hilltop Excellence Awards ceremony at SMU in April. The 2019 Sheri Mooney award recognized three students whose "Christian faith is evident as a recognizable priority in their day-to-day campus life...and whose behavior, values and relationships, reflect the quality of their commitment to Christ." Smythe's commitment to leading others in faith has been exemplary in his four years of involvement with SMU Catholic Campus Ministry. Smythe—who comes from an Episcopalian Christian background—found his church home at SMU Catholic early in his college career.

Despite the potential for this slight difference in faith tradition to be a source of friction for Smythe, he instead used it as an opportunity to live ecumenism with excellence. Taking full advantage of his ability to create community and draw others into friendship, Smythe served in several leadership roles within SMU Catholic. In particular, he led small groups for first year students as a FYSH (First Year Student Homes) leader for two years, and his senior year served as director of the FYSH program, teaching other small group leaders how to lead.

Smythe will graduate this spring with a degree in mechanical engineering, and will begin work this summer with Barrios Technology, a NASA contractor in Houston, Texas.
