Series: What do the pictures in the stained glass in the Main Church depict?




Let's start with the three scenes behind the altar. These three scenes represent the death, Resurrection, and Second Coming of Christ.



The far left shows the death of Jesus. Notice the two figures next to Him? One is Mary, and the other is St. John the Evangelist, our patron saint and the only apostle to stay with Jesus during His Crucifixion.

The far right image depicts Jesus' Resurrection. The angel represents the angels who told the disciples that Jesus had risen from the dead.





The middle panel represents the Second Coming of Christ. After His Ascension, Jesus promised that He would come again, and we wait and prepare for His return.

Meet a Saint: St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa)

born in 1910 and died in 1997. Mother Teresa is best known for her work among the poor in Calcutta, India and for founding an order of religious sisters, known as the Missionaries of Charity. Mother Teresa had a unique gift of being able to see past a person's poverty, disability, or illness and see him or her as an individual. Her mission was not to solve the world's poverty but to restore the dignity of each and every human person one individual at a time. She is known for her humility and encouraged all of us to do "small things with great love." Although she was often plagued with doubts, Mother Teresa held strong in her faith through her whole life and is a great modern role model for us all to live by.

Saint Teresa was canonized by Pope Francis just two months ago. Her feast day is September 5th.
