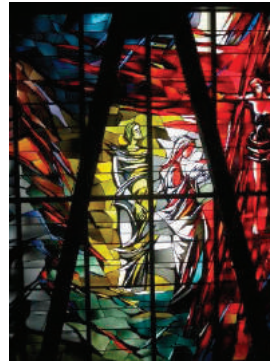

Did you know?

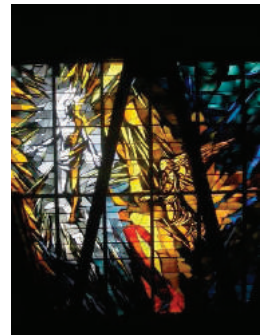
Series: What do the pictures in the stained glass in the Main Church depict?



Let's start with the three scenes behind the altar. These three scenes represent the death, Resurrection, and Second Coming of Christ.



The far left shows the death of Jesus. Notice the two figures next to Him? One is Mary, and the other is St. John the Evangelist, our patron saint and the only apostle to stay with Jesus during His Crucifixion.



The far right image depicts Jesus' Resurrection. The angel represents the angels who told the disciples that Jesus had risen from the dead.



The middle panel represents the Second Coming of Christ. After His Ascension, Jesus promised that He would come again, and we wait and prepare for His return.

Meet a Saint: St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa)



Most saints seem like they were around a long time ago, but St. Teresa of Calcutta (known as Mother Teresa) was a saint of our times – she was



born in 1910 and died in 1997. Mother Teresa is best known for her work among the poor in Calcutta, India and for founding an order of religious sisters, known as the Missionaries of Charity. Mother Teresa had a unique gift of being able to see past a person's poverty, disability, or illness and see him or her as an individual. Her mission was not to solve the world's poverty but to restore the dignity of each and every human person one individual at a time. She is known for her humility and encouraged all of us to do "small things with great love." Although she was often plagued with doubts, Mother Teresa held strong in her faith through her whole life and is a great modern role model for us all to live by.

Saint Teresa was canonized by Pope Francis just two months ago. Her feast day is September 5th.

Welcome Fr. Rojas!

This week, a new priest has come to serve God by serving our community: Fr. Arthur F. Rojas. Fr. Rojas is a native of Queens Village, New York (b. 1968) and was ordained for our archdiocese in 2006. A 'late vocation', Fr. Rojas had practiced law and participated in the civic and political life of Queens County before answering God's persistent call to the sacred priesthood. Our new parochial vicar is a graduate of the University of Virginia (B.A., Foreign Affairs, 1990), Cardozo School of Law (J.D., 1993), and St. Joseph's Seminary (M.Div/S.T.B.. *summa cum laude*, 2006). He has been published in *Eastern Churches Journal*, *Sacerdos*, and *The Dunwoodie Review*.

The eldest son of Colombian immigrants, Fr. Rojas is fully fluent in both English and Spanish. He is grateful for this opportunity to add a chapter in beautiful Putnam County to his ten years of ministry, having served in Yonkers, the South Bronx, and Monticello (his last assignment was Administrator of a parish in Yonkers). Fr. Rojas looks forward to meeting all of us, whether personally or in the sacred rites of our Church.

El mayor de tres hijos de inmigrantes colombianos, Padre Rojas nació y fue criado en la comuna de Queens en la ciudad de Nueva York. Se graduó de la Universidad de Virginia (B.A., Asuntos Exteriores, 1990), la facultad de derecho “Cardozo” de la Universidad Yeshiva, Nueva York (J.D., 1993) y del Seminario de San José, Yonkers (Maestría de Divinidad, 2006). Ejerció una carrera profesional y militaba en la vida cívica y política de su comuna antes de acudir al llamado de DIOS en 1999 y comenzar su formación sacerdotal en 2000 por nuestra arquidiócesis. Aunque **no** ejerce ahora como abogado, Padre Rojas se mantiene al día de noticias de varios sectores del gobierno en cuanto afectan el bien común de la comunidad, el bienestar de nuestra gente hispana y los derechos de nuestra Iglesia y sus fieles.

Además de ayudar a los Padres Caruso y McCarthy con **toda** nuestra parroquia enorme, **está Padre Rojas a nuestra disposición** en la Casa Cural (salvo **los jueves y parte de los viernes**). Le interesa a nuestro nuevo padre espiritual de conocer a todos los hispanos de nuestra zona y buscar como ampliar la presencia hispana en nuestra parroquia e Iglesia. **¡Brindémosle un saludo caluroso al Padre Rojas!
