

God bless you all.






## News from Peddakorukondi Parish

**Participating in the General Assembly with the theme: “*The Synodality in the Structures of the Congregation at all levels*” (September 15-30, 2021)**



In this Assembly, the Province of Vietnam presented and shared several specific activities and experiences of the Province in the cultural context of Vietnam. The General Government encouraged and appreciated several mission activities of the Province in the following areas:

**In the area of taking care of Retired Priests:** Through past years, the MF confreres of the Province of Vietnam have been taking care of the retired priests at the Priests’ House in the Diocese of Phu Cuong.

**In the area of the Pastoral Care of Migrants and Itinerant People:** For many years, Fr. Thomas Truong Hoang Phuc, M.F., has been appointed by the Bishop of Phu Cuong Diocese to be in charge of the Office for Pastoral Care of Migrants and Itinerant People of the Diocese. This is a particular apostolate with a very wide range of activities. In addition, there are RCIA Classes, Marriage catechism, and other activities for emigrants. 

### The Online Meeting of the Vietnamese Province

On December 13, 2021, Fr. Thomas Dinh Ngoc Loc, MF, the Provincial Superior, hosted an Online Meeting of the Brethren of all the Communities and Missions of the Province in Vietnam and at abroad with the theme: "Vietnamese Province of the Missionaries of Faith: Communion, Participation, and Mission".



The meeting went on well and yielded many spiritual fruits of communion and solidarity among the members of the Province. The Provincial Governance also had the opportunity to listen to the thoughts and aspirations of the Brethren in the whole Province, especially the Brethren who are in the Northern Vietnam Missions and the brothers who are studying at abroad.

The meeting ended with joy and optimism of all the members about a bright future for the development and promotion of the Province according to the pastoral direction of the Vietnamese Church and the Universal Church.

### **3. Serving in the Isolation Areas for Covid-19 Suspect Cases and Taking Care of the Covid-19 Patients at Hospitals**

From August 15 to October 15, there were 3 priests and 26 brothers of the Province of Vietnam who volunteered to serve in the isolation areas for Covid-19 suspect cases and taking care of the Covid-19 patients at hospitals in three provinces: Binh Duong, Dong Nai, and Saigon.



The volunteer trip went on well and left a lot of appreciative sympathy for the patients and medical staffs. The Missionaries of the Faith Brethren have truly become witnesses of the faith, and they have received much praise from the Diocesan Bishop and the local government. This is a meaningful experience for each volunteer, and all of them gained lot of spiritual benefits that contribute to promoting their vocation of the Missionaries of Faith.



#### 4. The canonical visitation (October 27-31, 2021)

Fr. Joseph Phan Trong Quang, General Councillor, being delegated by the Superior General made the canonical visitation in the Province of Vietnam from October 27 to 31, 2021. During the visit Fr. Joseph had common and private meetings with the Provincial Governance, Formation Board, priests, deacons, all brothers with the perpetual vows who have completed the theological program, and all brothers at the God's Word Institute.



During the visitation Fr. Joseph listened to reports on the following specific contents:

- **The Province of Vietnam:** Annual and extraordinary plans related to the individual member, the organic structure of the Congregation, formation, administration, community development, and mission activities of the Vietnamese Province.
- **The God's Word Institute:** The activities and missions of The Community of the God's Word Institute.
- **Formation:** Evaluations of personnel and training plans of the Province of Vietnam and the formation projects.

The visit ended with the Fr. Joseph making the evaluation and writing a summary of the canonical visitation programme as stated in the MF Constitutions and the General Directory. The thanksgiving Mass was celebrated by Fr. Joseph with all brothers at the institute's chapel.

Currently the Province of Vietnam has more than 224 members, including 61 priests, 07 deacons, 89 brothers, 14 novices, and more than 54 postulants, serving in 12 dioceses and three foreign missionary regions.
