ATTENDANCE IS UP

We observed a 3% decrease in Mass attendance each year for 13 straight years. Overall, in the last two years, we have recorded an *increase* in Mass attendance.



100% ENGAGEMENT

Each church parish throughout our diocese is engaged with our diocesan strategic planning process and has crafted a unique plan to guide its renewal.



FOCUSED ON ADULTS

Every church parish is focusing on better formation for adults and intends to begin small groups for adults within the next two years.
