GREGORIAN MASSES

Gregorian Masses are a series of Masses for one particular living or deceased person, offered on 30 consecutive days. They are named after Pope St. Gregory the Great who was Pope from 590 to 604. Tradition holds that when a monk named Justus died, Pope St. Gregory had the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass offered for the repose of his soul on 30 consecutive days. At the end of that time, Justus is said to have appeared to his brother, assuring him that he, Justus, had been released from Purgatory.

Consequently, the custom of offering 30 "Gregorian Masses" for one particular deceased person spread throughout the Christian world and is in practice today.

A living person receiving these masses for 30 consecutive days would be for a very particular intention ~ a person having deep struggle and spiritual need.

The Society for the Propagation of the Faith supports the tradition of sending offerings for the celebration of Gregorian Masses by priests in mission dioceses. Mission priests depend greatly on Mass offerings for their support as they serve among the very poor. They are willing to accept the special responsibility of celebrating Gregorian Masses, the 30-day series of Masses for one deceased person. In many instances, Mass offerings are the only support available to many mission priests.

Spiritually, as you unite yourself with the priest who offers the Sacrifice of the Mass for your intentions, you share a bond of great strength ~ love of Christ in the Eucharist, trust in His love for you and faith in the power of prayer.
