COLLECTION FOR THE CHURCH IN LATIN AMERICA (ACCT. #203470).....January 26, 2025

This collection supports pastoral programs throughout Latin America and the Caribbean. Projects include the work of evangelization, formation of laity, religious, and seminarians, as well as youth ministry and catechesis, and building construction only in cases of emergency. PASTORAL SOLIDARITY FUND FOR THE CHURCH IN AFRICA (ACCT. #203520)..... FEBRUARY 2, 2025

This collection provides grants to finance pastoral projects that support the maintenance and growth of the Church in Africa. Funded projects include outreach programs, schools, evangelization, and education of clergy and lay ministers. OPERATION RICE BOWL (ACCT. #203690)..... March 5 through April 20, 2025

This is a Lenten program run in schools and parishes. Proceeds benefit Catholic Relief Services' food security projects supporting agriculture, nutrition, education, and self-sufficiency in communities around the world. 25% of the proceeds are retained for the benefit of local antipoverty programs administered by Catholic Charities of Houma-Thibodaux. BLACK & INDIAN MISSION COLLECTION (ACCT. #203480).....March 9, 2025

These funds are distributed as grants to support and strengthen the evangelization of Black and Indian peoples in the U.S. Several church parishes in our diocese receive grants from this collection. CATHOLIC HOME MISSIONS APPEAL (Acct. #203445)..... April 27, 2025

This collection funds a wide range of pastoral services, evangelization, religious education, maintenance of mission parishes, training of seminarians and lay ministers, and ministry with ethnic groups in the U.S. and its territories and 85 Latin and Eastern Catholic dioceses. CATHOLIC COMMUNICATION CAMPAIGN COLLECTION (ACCT. #203500).....June 1, 2025

- WORLD MISSION SUNDAY COLLECTION (Acct. #203460 – Write check to Propagation of the Faith).....October 19, 2025**
 This collection is used to help promote the universal solidarity of Christians and recognize their common responsibility with regard to the evangelization of the world. 91% of this collection is sent to The Society of the Propagation of the Faith and 9% of this collection is sent to Catholic Near East Welfare Association. - MILITARY SERVICES COLLECTION (Acct. #203530)..... NOVEMBER 9, 2025**
 This collection funds the Archdiocese for the Military Services' Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program which identifies vocations within the military and is now educating 30 men for the priesthood and subsequent military chaplaincy. Currently, 285 Catholic military chaplains provide pastoral care to over 1.5 million Catholics on ships, in combat, on bases, and in 153 VA hospitals.
- CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT (Acct. #203490).....November 16, 2025**
 This collection uses grants to support community-controlled, self-help organizations and transformative education to address the root causes of poverty in America. 75% of this collection is administered by the Subcommittee on the Catholic Campaign for Human Development with the approval of local bishops. 25% of this collection is retained for local efforts through Catholic Charities of Houma-Thibodaux.
