RECLAIMING MY CATHOLIC FAITH

Week 6 Meditation on Prayer

Everyone knows someone who has said, "I quit going to church because I prayed for something and God didn't answer my prayer."

That makes it kind of scary to pray. What if God doesn't answer my prayers? There's more to prayer than expecting God to give you anything you want or even seem to need.

Prayer is an act of the virtue of religion which consists in asking for proper gifts of graces from God. In a more general sense, it is the application of the mind to Divine things. It is a means by which Christians can acquire union with God here on earth.

There are four types of prayer:

- Thanksgiving
 - Praise
 - Adoration
 - Petition

There are three different ways to pray:

- Community prayer
 - Vocal prayer
 - Mental prayer

Although we don't usually think of it like this, prayer is first and foremost a duty. We owe the God who created us and redeemed us praise and thanksgiving.

Adoration is a form of prayer based on a deep love for God.

Petition is the most common form of prayer. Oftentimes, we ask God for things that are important to us, or, to those closest to us. It is not wrong to pray for things we need. We should remember, though, that God does not always give us the temporal things we think we need, but God always gives us the graces we need for salvation. Sometimes, things we ask for may not be beneficial for our or others' salvation. God cannot grant something that is not beneficial to our salvation.

What should we pray for? First, we should pray for deeper Faith, fuller Hope in the resurrection and greater Charity for others. Then, we should hold up those other needs we have.

God answers prayers first and foremost by bestowing grace. Sometimes, God grants a supernatural grace that affects the natural world and that is called a miracle. Sometimes, the greatest miracle is when someone has a change of heart.

Questions:

- Do I take time to pray?
- Do I prioritize praise and thanksgiving in my prayer?
 - Does my love for God overflow into my prayer?
