# Pastor's Column



#### Catholic Funerals Are Different

Catholics are choosing cremation in greater rates than ever. Just a generation ago, cremation was unimaginable for a practicing Catholic, but the Holy See gave permission for Catholics to be cremated in good conscience.

However, there are still some provisions to remember because Catholic funerals should be different:

- 1. Catholics are not permitted to "scatter the ashes" of another Catholic.
- 2. Catholic remains must be buried, even if they are cremated. They may not be placed in a container or (multiple containers) and remain in a home or homes.
  - 3. The body of a Catholic may not be disposed by a recent means called "flameless cremation" or Alkaline Hydrolysis.

Catholic funeral customs are different because they are dictated by our belief in the bodily resurrection of the dead.

Unlike the funerals of statesmen and celebrities which are designed to be viewed on television and include entertainment and informative aspects, the Catholic Funeral is intended as a supplication before God for the soul of the deceased and as comfort to the mourners.

Catholics should plan that the Mass be central to their funeral rites. Nothing benefits the soul of the deceased more than the offering of Holy Mass. The graces of Mass, the prayers of the clergy and mourners and the unity with Christ in His death and resurrection benefit the souls of the dead more than any other action or monument.

In a world where anyone who dies is naively and immediately assumed to be in heaven with God, Catholics understand the truth of the sinful human condition and the extent of God's Divine mercy. We understand that prayers for the dead are important and how we treat the remains of the deceased expresses our belief in Jesus Christ.

Unbelievers usually eulogize the dead in an attempt to extend or even shape the memory of a loved one. Their accomplishments are listed, funny antidotes are told and special memories are shared. But hopefully Catholics realize that the dead stand now before God in need of His mercy and our prayers. While the eulogy is not antithetical to the Catholic understanding of the Funeral Mass, it is not always appropriate.

Catholic Funerals are different because we believe differently from the world. That's okay, we hold the truth and we should act like it!

# RECLAIMING MY CATHOLIC FAITH

#### Week 8 Meditation on Hope

Last week we reflected on the Theological Virtue called faith. The theological virtues are supernatural gifts that God bestows on specific individuals of His choosing. The supernatural virtues of faith, hope, and love lead to eternal happiness.

Faith is a childlike trust in God. Hope is derived from Faith. Trusting in God necessarily leads to a supernatural hope in a reward for that trust. Hope is a trust that God will save us from sin and death. Faith leads us to the Gospel. The Gospel leads us to hope in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Resurrection of Jesus gives us hope that He will raise us up from the dead.

Hope is a gift from God by which the intellect is illuminated to the knowledge that God will give us the grace necessary to attain everlasting life. Ultimately, hope brings happiness to the soul, contentment to the mind, and resignation to the will, for each action that a person filled with hope performs is directed toward attaining heaven. When Jesus promised His disciples that he would "give a peace that the world cannot give" He was referring to the supernatural gift of hope.

Hope can be distorted into presumption. It is not uncommon for a person to presume God will forgive a sin, this is another sin called presumption. Hope makes us vigilant to avoid sin, presumption lets us fall into sin without compunction or remorse.

#### Other virtues derived from Hope

Joy – a disposition flowing from trust in God's ultimate goodness.

Prayer – a sense that God will hear us in our need.

Penance – a sense that God forgives the repentant soul.

Peace – a sense that everything that begins with Christ will end with Him.

#### **Questions:**


Do I presume God's mercy without true amendment of life? Do I hope for eternal happiness over earthly happiness? Do I have inner peace?




