#### Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller



#### Preserving Our Heritage

One of the physical signs of a vibrant parish is the need to update and replace existing features because they receive lots of use. This is true at Assumption.

We are planning two major purchases in the next few months and we need your help.

One major purchase is to update our sound system in the church. The current sound system has been stretched to beyond its capacity to provide quality and reliable sound for our liturgical ceremonies. While volume is not an issue, the sound is not nearly as clear as it could be. Aging parishioners are often already struggling with the ambient noise from other people moving, children crying and the sound of the HVAC running and since the speakers do not give a crisp and clear sound, it is even more difficult for them to hear what the priest, deacon or lector says. When we had carpeting the dampening effect assisted those with some hearing impairment but it also significantly muted the quality of the music. Incidentally, since we replaced the flooring, the number of compliments about music at Assumption has greatly increased. Since the instruments, the vocalists and the director hasn't changed, what has improved is the congregations ability to appreciate the already good music. Carpeting is terrible for church music.

The good news is that there is a win-win scenario with new technology. Parishioners can hear the spoken word clearly and we can appreciate quality music. To achieve this we have called in a company that has vastly improved the sound in other churches. The total cost for this improvement is \$60,000.

The second update is to our Assumption utility vehicle. This truck is essential to our operation by offering us the opportunity to clear snow ourselves and to haul garbage and supplies easily. Owning our own vehicle saves the parish a lot of money over time and for a campus with buildings that are spread out and so much parking it is indispensable on an almost daily basis. The truck is a matter of fiscal responsibility and good order and not a luxury item. The current pick-up truck is from 1993 and it has pushed a lot of snow and hauled a lot of stuff. Maintenance costs to keep is running are expected to outweigh its value soon. Now is the time to replace it before it is out of service during a critical situation. Our parish maintenance committee has researched the type of vehicle and the accessories we need and the estimated cost to replace the pick up with a new or "gently used" plow-ready vehicle is \$50,000.

So this year's Preserving Our Heritage Appeal for the new church sound system and the new pick-up has a goal of \$110,000. Please consider making a sacrificial gift to Assumption for the Preserving Our Heritage Appeal so we can continue to be a vibrant and fiscally responsible parish.

# RECLAIMING MY CATHOLIC FAITH

#### Week 11 Meditation on the Spiritual Works of Mercy

Last week, we reflected on the Corporal Works of Mercy. This week we want to focus on the Spiritual Works of Mercy.

The Corporal Works of Mercy express the virtues of charity and justice. The Spiritual Works of Mercy express the virtues of Prudence and Faith.

#### The Spiritual Works of Mercy are:

- To instruct the ignorant;
- To counsel the doubtful;
  - To admonish sinners;
- To bear wrongs patiently;
- To forgive offences willingly;
  - To comfort the sorrowful;
- To pray for the living and the dead.

There is a tendency today to gravitate toward the Corporal Works of Mercy because one sees an immediate physical improvement in another person's life. While the Spiritual Works of Mercy may leave an almost unperceivable impact on others, they are no less important.

Our entire Catholic School system is based on instructing the ignorant and counseling the doubtful, as we educate and instill faith in young people.

But several of the Spiritual Works of Mercy have been almost forgotten; admonishing sinners and praying for the dead are not fashionable today. All the more reason to cultivate these Spiritual Works of Mercy in our own lives.

Admonishing sinners is not meant to make them feel badly or to prove our own moral superiority, but to gently and charitably direct them to the truth.

Praying for the dead is the responsibility of the family and, by extension, of the friends and the parish community. An ultimate act of spiritual charity is to pray for the poor souls who have no one to pray for them.

If a parish is healthy, it expresses the Spiritual Works of Mercy as well as it expresses the Corporal Works of Mercy. Similarly, a Catholic is fully alive when they are performing the Spiritual Works of Mercy regularly.

#### Questions:

Do I shy away from some Spiritual Works of Mercy?

Do I express patience with others?

Am I zealous for the truth?




