

More Opportunities to Help Others

One of the *Corporal Works of Mercy* is to "bury the dead." Of course, one does not have to actually dig in the ground and place the body; one can pray for the faithful departed or care for the mourners.

Assumption has a few funerals each month. There are two groups of parishioners who exemplify the Corporal Work of Mercy: to bury the dead – they are the Resurrection Funeral Choir and the Post Funeral Lunch Volunteers.

The Resurrection Funeral Choir prays for the dead by providing sacred music at Funeral Masses. They also provide a compassionate presence for grieving families at Funeral Masses. Families are always grateful for the inspirational music and their presence.

Funerals are usually scheduled Monday – Saturday anytime between 9:30am and Noon. They usually last about an hour. Choir members are not committed to every funeral, just the ones they can make. The Funeral Choir varies in size all the time based on members' availability. The music is simple to sing and there are no regular practices.

If you are interested in helping the Resurrection Funeral Choir, sign up on our website <u>assumptionstl.org</u> or contact Nancy Pyle at <u>pylen@assumptionstl.org</u>.

Post Funeral Lunch Volunteers care for grieving family and friends of deceased parishioners by providing a fellowship meal after the funeral. Five teams rotate so the same people are not responsible for every funeral. Each team has a *Captain* and a back-up *Co-Captain* to coordinate details with the parish office. Each team needs three *Callers* to contact approximately twelve *Chefs*. However, the amount of calls depends on how many guests are expected at a funeral lunch.

Each team needs thirty-six *Chefs* to prepare one dish and deliver it to the St. Marie Hall the morning of the funeral. Possible dishes include casseroles, mostaccioli plates, cheesy potatoes, pasta salads, egg salads, potato salads, fruit salads, garden salads, and cakes, brownies, or cookies. Each team needs four *Servers* to set up, serve the meal, and clean up. They spend a few hours preparing everything and serving the two-hour luncheon.

The more volunteers we have, the less often any one parishioner has to shoulder the burdens.

The Assumption Shuttle!

Through the incredible generosity of a parishioner, Assumption has a shuttle available for our parish organizations and for seniors with mobility issues living within our parish boundaries. Seniors with mobility issues may schedule a ride to Holy Mass, parish activities and, if the shuttle is available, it may assist them with other needs.

Assumption Shuttle is used for these purposes:

- · Excursions for parish organizations.
- Transportation to and from Holy Mass, senior ministry events, and other parish events.

In the future we hope to add these services:

• If the shuttle and drivers are available, seniors can request transportation to and from doctor's visits within a 10-mile radius or trips to the grocery store.

The following groups will have priority when scheduling:

- 1. Special events for parish organizations
- 2. Transporting seniors and disabled to Sunday Masses
 - 3. Senior Ministry regularly scheduled events
- 4. Maybe in the future: Transporting seniors and disabled to doctor's visits
- 5. Maybe in the future: Transporting seniors and disabled to grocery store

Assumption Shuttle will assist any senior living in our parish boundaries, but in cases of high demand, parishioners will be given priority.

All transportation is dependent on the availability of our volunteer drivers.

Rules:

- Only approved drivers may operate vehicle and wheelchair lift.
- Parish organizations must pay for any fuel they use (return shuttle with filled tank.)
- No food or drink (except in sealable containers)
- Passengers in wheelchairs may require another adult to accompany them to and from the shuttle.
- Ambulatory passengers must be able to board the shuttle unassisted.
- Seatbelts must be used at all times and passengers must remain seated.
- Passengers must complete waivers before initial use.
- Passenger recommended donation \$5 per ride.

For updates on the Assumption Shuttle register at <u>flocknotes.com</u> and join the group "Transportation Updates and News." Seniors and their caregivers are welcome to sign up to receive cancelations due to inclement weather and other relevant information.

To become a volunteer driver contact our transportation coordinator. We will train potential drivers and help them become qualified drivers.

These are the requirements:

- -Assumption driver's age minimum: 25 years old
- Valid Driver's License
- Proof of insurance
- Approval by the pastor
- Approval of Assumption Safety Coordinator
- Completion of Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program

The middle school has been working in the Math 360 lab all school year. Research shows that students work best when able to be comfortable and when they can work collaboratively. The 5th-8th graders use a classroom with white boards around the room and are often able to work together. They are able to talk through math problems, helping each other to see where they have made mistakes and how to fix their problems. This also allows the teacher to immediately see if a students is making an error and attempt to fix the error much quicker than if it was done on paper, turned in, and graded a few days later. We love the math 360 lab and look forward to using this math lab for many years to come.

In the Gospel today, Jesus says "I give you a new commandment: love one another.... This is how all will know that you are my
