




First Saturday Public Square Rosary

More Opportunities to Help

Assumption is blessed to have its own cemetery. It is rare for a St. Louis parish to have this precious resource. It gives parishioners a real sense of having roots here. Accordingly, many Assumption families are multi-generational. Also it gives all of us a sense of the history of Assumption Parish. The oldest gravestones are from the 1850s.

Last year, our Cemetery Committee surveyed parts of the cemetery and located space for hundreds of additional burials. Some places still remain, but we are hoping to find more space in other areas. **If you are still interested in purchasing a full grave or cremains grave, please contact Denise in the Parish Office 314-487-7970 ext1235.**

Our Volunteer Grass Cutters keep the cemetery (and the other lawns) looking fantastic. They usually cut on Wednesday afternoons around 3pm, weather permitting. Some guys cut each week; others can only make it a couple times a month. The parish has the mowers and beverages to make the volunteer's job easy. **If you are interested in becoming a mower, contact the Ken Dunn 314-406-0511.**

I feel like Assumption has a responsibility to keep the cemetery a beautiful and peaceful place. Age, lightning strikes, ice, and windstorms have taken their toll on some the trees in the cemetery. Eventually, they will have to come down. The best way to keep the cemetery beautiful and peaceful is to occasionally plant new trees. Recently, we planted nine new Missouri-Native trees in memory of parishioners. A beautiful bronze placard identifies loved ones at the base of the tree. I would like to plant more trees this year. **If you are interested in sponsoring a new tree in the cemetery, contact Denise in the parish office 314-487-7970 ext1235.**

Remember to pray for your loved ones who have died, for all our deceased parishioners, and for all the souls in Purgatory.

The Assumption Shuttle!

Through the incredible generosity of a parishioner, Assumption has a shuttle available for our parish organizations and for seniors with mobility issues living within our parish boundaries. Seniors with mobility issues may schedule a ride to Holy Mass, parish activities and, if the shuttle is available, it may assist them with other needs.

Assumption Shuttle is used for these purposes:

- Excursions for parish organizations.
- Transportation to and from Holy Mass, senior ministry events, and other parish events.

In the future we hope to add these services:

- If the shuttle and drivers are available, seniors can request transportation to and from doctor's visits within a 10-mile radius or trips to the grocery store.

The following groups will have priority when scheduling:

1. Special events for parish organizations
2. Transporting seniors and disabled to Sunday Masses
3. Senior Ministry regularly scheduled events
4. *Maybe in the future:* Transporting seniors and disabled to doctor's visits
5. *Maybe in the future:* Transporting seniors and disabled to grocery store

Assumption Shuttle will assist any senior living in our parish boundaries, but in cases of high demand, parishioners will be given priority.

All transportation is dependent on the availability of our volunteer drivers.

Rules:

- Only approved drivers may operate vehicle and wheelchair lift.
- Parish organizations must pay for any fuel they use (return shuttle with filled tank.)
- No food or drink (except in sealable containers)
- Passengers in wheelchairs may require another adult to accompany them to and from the shuttle.
- Ambulatory passengers must be able to board the shuttle unassisted.
- Seatbelts must be used at all times and passengers must remain seated.
- Passengers must complete waivers before initial use.
- Passenger recommended donation \$5 per ride.

For updates on the Assumption Shuttle register at flocknotes.com and join the group "Transportation Updates and News." Seniors and their caregivers are welcome to sign up to receive cancellations due to inclement weather and other relevant information.

To become a volunteer driver contact our transportation coordinator.

We will train potential drivers and help them become qualified drivers.

These are the requirements:

- Assumption driver's age minimum: 25 years old
- Valid Driver's License
- Proof of insurance
- Approval by the pastor
- Approval of Assumption Safety Coordinator
- Completion of Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program


