Pastor's Column

Recent Priests from our Parish Serving Deployed Military

Fr. David Miloscia, our associate pastor from 2014-2018, who is currently serving at Ste. Genevieve Parish in Ste. Gen, Mo. recently received permission from Archbishop Carlson to serve in the Military Archdiocese. He had been seriously considering this move even when he was at Assumption. As you may know, the whole Miloscia family is very dedicated to the Church and our country; they have two sons who serve as priests and a son who has served in the military. While at Assumption, Fr. Miloscia served as a chaplain to our local St. Louis County Police precinct. I think that experience helped him develop a desire to serve full time as a chaplain.

Fr. Miloscia will be leaving St. Louis in January to begin his training to serve in the U.S. Navy as a Catholic Chaplain. After he finishes his training, it is planned that Fr. Miloscia will be assigned to the nuclear powered, super-carrier USS Ronald Reagan, which is currently serving in the Pacific Ocean near Japan, North and South Korea and the South China Sea.

Fr. Miloscia is not the first priest from Assumption to discern a ministry to the Military Archdiocese. Fr. Ed Ramatowski also left St. Louis to serve as a military chaplain. Recently, he was serving overseas near combat areas.

Serving as a military chaplain is a very difficult assignment and those priests make tremendous personal sacrifices to minister to the men and women in the military.

The military is in dire need for Catholic chaplains. So priest chaplains serve for as long as they can depending on their health, abilities, and other circumstances. Just like other military personnel, chaplains are often in harm's way and may return to recover from injury or PTSD. Sometimes, chaplains return to their home diocese to serve in the Reserves after active duty. Ultimately, some day, God willing, Fr. Miloscia will return to St. Louis to serve in an archdiocesan parish again.

We wish Fr. Miloscia well in his new ministry and please remember to pray for him, Fr. Ramatowski and all the priests who have the enormous task of ministering to the Catholics and the others in the military.

Assumption Snow Policy

1. Regularly scheduled Masses

Regularly scheduled Masses are never cancelled. However, liturgical ministers and musicians are released from their responsibilities during a significant winter weather event. It should be noted that the obligation of attending Holy Mass is mitigated if it is unsafe to travel.

2. Communication

Parish closures (including the parish office, youth/senior ministries, PSR, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, parish meetings and the Adoration Chapel) will be posted parish-wide on *Flocknote* and on the *Facebook* “Assumption Parish and School” page.

Grade School and ELC closures will be posted on FOX2, KMOV, KSDK and communicated to parents electronically by *Brightwheel* and *FastDirect*.

Athletic Association game cancellations can be found on the Assumption Athletics *Twitter* feed and the *CYC website*. Coaches communicate practice cancellations to their teams via email or text.

3. Snow removal

Usually, snow will not be removed until the storm ends, unless weekend Masses are affected, in which case, we will try to keep the sidewalks and the lot open. If the school or PSR closes, expect all activities to cancel to give the maintenance crew the opportunity to safely clear the sidewalks and lot.

4. The Adoration Chapel

Adoration is suspended during any significant winter weather event. Snow and ice accumulate quickly on the entrance ramp. Therefore, adoration is suspended when precipitation begins to fall and normally resumes the next day at 9 a.m. in order to give the maintenance crew time to remove the snow or ice from the parking lot and ramp.

Important Announcement Regarding “Protecting God’s Children”

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. **Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required to register in the new system. This includes all clergy, employees and volunteers who are currently in compliance and those new to service.** All new registrants will need to attend a Protecting God’s Children workshop. For those who have already attended a Protecting God’s Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition, everyone will register for an updated background screening, view two online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct.

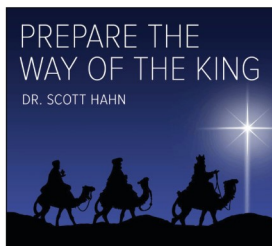
