

<u>Dynamic Catholic, Alive!</u> -The Power of Fasting

Jesus provides a marvelous example for us as we continue the beginning of our Lenten journey. Many of us have forgotten the great blessing and strengthening that fasting provides for us. When we fast from food, we understand more vividly how each meal is a blessing from God and God shows us our need to rely on Him for sustenance. Fasting must not simply pertain to food however. We can fast from false gods like our Lord did in the desert. We can fast from overuse of social media, technology, desire for power or recognition, sloth, or selfish use of our material resources. As we enter into the desert with the Lord for the next 40 days, let us pray for the gift of generosity and the grace to lead more simple lives, lives that radiate joy and hope in the most important thing: salvation in Christ. 

An Invitation for Lent

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration began at Assumption on March 16, 1994. Since then, day and night, our parishioners have kept watch in prayer and penance in our Adoration Chapel.

During this Lent, consider giving one hour a week to God by offering prayers in the Adoration Chapel. You can try out adoration for the season of Lent without making a long-term commitment. If at the end of the Lenten Season, you want to remain an adorer, great! If not, we are glad you made your Lent special.

Our goal is to have every hour covered with at least two adorers.

Why become an adorer?

Every adorer has a different reason for coming once a week. Some say they find peace in the chapel. Others say they need the time to pray to help them through the week. But you have to answer this question yourself. Maybe the best reason I've heard is a man who said, "heaven is going to be perpetual adoration of the Trinity, I better start getting used to it now!"

What do I do for an hour?

The time should be spent in spiritual work. There are many different ways to spend the hour. First genuflect and take your place, kneel down and take a moment to remember you are in God's presence. Then some people like to pray the Rosary or spend time with spiritual reading. (There is a large collection of spiritual books on hand.) You may prefer to just talk to Jesus, or to sit quietly and let Him speak to you in your heart.

What happens if I can't make it?

There is a list where you can request a sub in the chapel. Other adorers are very generous in signing up to take the place of a person who can't make it. The chapel is considered closed during winter weather events, so if there is snow or ice falling, you do not have to fulfill your hour.

Is there a restroom nearby?

Yes.

Is the chapel secure and how do I get access to the chapel?

There is a combination lock on the door. The Parish Office or the priests can give you the combination to enter the chapel.

How do I become an adorer?

There is a sign up in the back of church for the next few weeks. Simply choose a time, fill out a commitment form, and begin as soon as possible.




