

Slowly Reopening Assumption

Several South County parishes are preparing to allow groups to start meeting again. The number of new coronavirus cases reported in our zip code continues to be minimal so I feel confident that as long as parishioners maintain common sense precautions and follow the social distancing guidelines encouraged by St. Louis County, everyone will be safe. Food and drink should not be served at this time.

The shut-down has provided us the opportunity to consolidate and prioritize our scheduling process. We are completing a long-term migration to Google Calendars from individual and paper calendars. At this point, no meetings or events are on the parish calendar. All group leaders should contact Margot at the Rectory before announcing a meeting time and place. Even if your group has met forever in the same time and place, someone from your group must reschedule to reserve the room.

- The parish calendar opens for reservations June 22.
- Small meetings (approximately 10 people) can begin on July 1.
- We are waiting for permission for large meetings and events from St. Louis County and the Archdiocese.

New rules are in place for scheduling rooms.

- 1. Liturgies, parish events, educational events, and parish ministries will have priority over small groups and private events.
- 2. Requests should be in writing. Please send your requests to <u>reservations@assumptionstl.org</u> or drop off at the Rectory.
- 3. Rooms can be scheduled for one year at a time.
- 4. The leaders' contact information must be provided.

Calendars for our liturgies, parish ministries and schools will be accessible online at <u>assumptionstl.org</u>.

The process for picking up keys (if you need them) remains the same. Keys can be picked up between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Rectory.





Welcome Archbishop-Elect Rozanski!

On June 10th, Archbishop Carlson celebrated his 11th anniversary as archbishop of St. Louis. It also was the day Pope Francis officially accepted his resignation and appointed a new archbishop of St. Louis. Archbishop-Elect Mitchell Thomas Rozanski will be installed as the 10th archbishop of St. Louis on August 25, 2020 at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis.

Archbishop-elect Rozanski was ordained a priest for Baltimore in 1984. In 2004, Pope John Paul II appointed him to be ordained an auxiliary bishop of Baltimore. Pope Francis named him to be the bishop of Springfield, Massachusetts in 2014.

Archbishop-elect Rozanski gave a news conference on June 10th at the Cathedral Basilica, where he commented on the many issues facing the St. Louis region and the archdiocese, including the continuing effects of the coronavirus, racism, Catholic education, changing demographics and parish life, and clergy sex abuse transparency.

Archbishop Carlson will continue to lead the Archdiocese as the Apostolic Administrator until Archbishop-elect Rozanski's Installation Mass on August 25.

August 25th is a fitting day for the Installation Mass because it is the liturgical feast of St. Louis, the King, the patron of our city and archdiocese.

The Installation Mass of a Bishop is filled with symbolism. The pope is usually represented by the Apostolic Nuncio (a bishop who is serves as a Vatican ambassador). The Nuncio presents the candidate to the Priest's Council and the faithful of the diocese by the proclamation of a document signed by the Pope himself. Then, once the priests acknowledge the legitimacy of the document, the former bishop or another bishop of the region leads the new bishop to a chair known as the "cathedra", which symbolizes the bishop's authority. Then, he is handed the "crosier," which is the staff that symbolizes the responsibility of the bishop to care for his flock. Finally, the new Archbishop sits on the cathedra with his crosier in hand as a sign of the continuing presence of the Apostles leading our local Catholic community.

Please pray for Archbishop Carlson as he prepares for retirement and a new phase in his long life of ministry to the Church. Please remember Archbishop-elect Rozanski in your prayers as he prepares for the challenging task of leaving his East Coast home and coming to a new place to proclaim the Gospel and preserve the Deposit of Faith as our new shepherd.




