

Room capacity limits

Church = 300 (50% of total capacity) Church Lower Level = 65 (50% of total capacity)

Fatima Room CLL = 12 (total capacity of the room to allow social distancing) Lourdes Room CLL = 12 (total capacity of the room to allow social distancing)

Rectory Basement = 12 (total capacity of the room to allow social distancing)

We have added the School Courtyard and the Outdoor Classroom to the list of potential meeting places. Please bring your own chairs.

Parish Meetings can resume again as long as the room capacity is not exceeded.

Mass guidelines

- Per Archbishop Carlson, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains temporarily lifted.
- Individuals over 60 should weigh the threat of the virus with other health problems caused by isolation and inactivity.
- Masks must be worn when entering an existing the church.
- Masks can be removed when seated in the pew.
- 6 feet distance should be observed between individuals or between non-family members when sitting in a pew, approaching Holy Communion, or conversing with others. Every other pew remains closed to encourage distancing.
- Holy Communion may be received on the tongue only when given by Fr. Keller or Fr. Weber.
- The Presentation of Offertory Gifts, the Sign of Peace and Communion under Both Kinds are suspended.

Funeral guidelines

- All funerals should follow the Mass guidelines given above.
- Visitations are permitted for one hour prior to the Funeral Mass.
- Funeral Luncheons are permitted in the Church Lower Level but only catered food is allowed.

Other

- Baptisms are permitted.
- Marriages must follow Mass guidelines.


