

† Usual contributions for Mass offerings are \$10. Please stop by the Parish Office during office hours to arrange to have a Mass said.



#### More Parish Updates

**PSR:** Coronavirus has reduced the number of families participating in PSR. This is not just at Assumption, but all the South County PSR programs are reporting low numbers.

For those who are participating, we have a different kind of PSR this year. Families are divided into cohorts and some Mondays they are assigned to attend in the church where confessions and Mass are available and other Mondays, they check in with their teachers via **Zoom.us**. Most of the catechetical projects will be done as a family at home. There is still time to register if you are interested!

**Seminarians:** Last year we had two great seminarians, Matthew Deken and Peter Pham, but like everything in Covid-land, they were unceremoniously cancelled. We regret not being able to give them a proper goodbye.

This year we have been assigned three seminarians who will begin on September 13th. Their names are:

- Eric Frieb, Theology I, from the Diocese of Dodge City
- Austin Sudkamp, Theology I, from Diocese of Springfield, IL
- Robert Lawson, Theology II, from Archdiocese of St. Louis

They will all be assisting with Sunday Masses. Eric and Austin will help out with our youth ministry and Robert will be involved in ministry to the elderly and sick here at Assumption.

**Outdoor Sacraments for vulnerable persons:** Exposure to Covid-19 can be dangerous for some people. Many have not been to Holy Mass or had the opportunity to make a good confession in many months. We are offering Confessions, Eucharistic Adoration and Mass on Tuesday evenings starting at 6 p.m., weather permitting on the Parish Center Parking Lot.

Inside Catholicism: Another program that bit the dust when the government shut down hit was Inside Catholicism. It is intended to offer insights into our Catholic Faith for parishioners and for people interested in becoming Catholic. This year Inside Catholicism will focus on the Spiritual Life of a Catholic. Starting on September 23, we will meet on Wednesdays at 7:15 p.m. Inside Catholicism will be a "hybrid meeting" —which means that we will have in-person participants meeting in the Church Lower Level and online participants using Zoom.us. 
# NEW Faith Mentorship Program for Families!
