



#AssumptionTogether Campaign Begins

Last week, we discussed the need to address a growing pandemic-induced deficit at Assumption. Although this is just a prediction, it is possible that the loss of fundraisers, reduction in the Sunday Collection and increased expenses in the School and Early Learning Center will combine to make a \$500,000 deficit by July 1, 2021. But if we do not address the problem now, it will become an insurmountable problem and, at some point, we will begin to run out of money needed to continue our many ministries at Assumption.

In order to address this issue, we are launching the #AssumptionTogether campaign. Soon we will ask parishioners to make "challenge gifts" to inspire giving at all levels. A challenge gift is a fundraising technique where major gifts are presented, and everyone is challenged to work together to match them. We hope to double or triple these challenge gifts in order to help fill the gap in our 2020-2021 budget.

I know that together we can continue our mission at Assumption if we work together. Assumption is a very generous and enthusiastic parish! We won't let this pandemic define us or defeat us. We will continue the work of Jesus Christ here with your help. Thank you!

Parish Updates

Despite Covidland, a lot is going on at Assumption. Here are a few updates:

In addition to the significant work being done by our Stewardship and Development Committee to address the projected deficit, our Fish Fry Committee is beginning to plan for a safe and successful way to reopen. Stay tuned! Obviously, the most anticipated moment in 2021 will be the Return of the Assumption Fish Fry!

Several parishioners have asked "why does this year's Stewardship Report identify 379 fewer households than last year?" If you remember, we conducted a parish census over a year ago and Margot, our parish secretary,

researched inactive parishioners only to find that over the years, many had moved or passed away. We continue to see many new families move into the parish and this reduction is not reflective of a sudden loss, just a long overdue census.

St. Louis County has raised our occupancy limit to 50%. We no longer require online sign-ups for Masses as the church fits 300 people comfortably. However, masks and a 6-foot social distance are still required.

One faculty member was exposed to Covid in the home and tested positive this week; St. Louis County Health Department asked us to switch our 5-8th graders to distance learning while the situation was evaluated. Because the school is following CDC guidelines, they allowed the students to return to in-person learning after only two days at home. We are praying for a full recovery of our faculty member who tested positive and are looking forward to their return.

St. Louis County also granted the permits needed to break ground on the new garage only 14 months after we applied for them. We are moving ahead on the garage since the Beyond Sunday funds were already set aside for this project and to abandon it at this point would needlessly waste the initial money that was invested long before the epidemic. To say I'm grumpy about the timing of the project is an understatement, but our Maintenance Committee has been amazing through all the ups and downs with the county government.

An invitation has been sent to Archbishop Rozanski to celebrate a Sunday Mass at Assumption. We hope to welcome him to Assumption sometime in the new year.

LifeTouch promises to deliver our parish picture directories in October. That poor company has been badly beat up by Covid and delays are regular, so we are hoping the directories make it.
