- 2. Complete the necessary fields: **First Name**, **Last Name**, **email address**, and **cell phone number**.
 - 3. Click the green "Add to Group" button.
- 4. Scroll through the list -- sorted alphabetically by Last Name -- to double check that your name now appears among the members in the group.


Prevent and Protect STL


