#### Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

In 2014, as I was packing my belongings at my last assignment in preparation for my move to Assumption, I received a phone call from a person in the Archdiocese warning me that Assumption only had enough money saved to cover two pay periods. He said, "two weekends of bad weather and low Mass attendance could put the parish and school in jeopardy." The news got worse after I moved in when I found out that our school enrollment had fallen dangerously low and we were already in discussions with neighboring schools to develop a regional solution.

But due to the conviction of the parishioners and school parents at Assumption, we turned the problems around in very little time. Soon, enrollment jumped and our financial situation improved. Later, I received another phone call from the Archdiocese congratulating Assumption and saying we were taken off the "endangered school list." I immediately asked, "What did it take to be on the list in the first place?" The answer was, "declining enrollment and lack of financial security." We should all be grateful to be off that list!

Not everyone may realize it, but tuition does not fully cover the faculty's salaries and the other expenses associated with the grade school. In fact, the parish contributes a large portion of the weekly Sunday collection to support our grade school. In theory, the AELC is self-supporting; however, often there are unbudgeted expenses that the parish covers.

But this year, the pandemic has seriously affected Sunday Mass attendance, resulting in a reduction of Offertory income and it has been difficult to hold successful fundraisers. The parish, therefore, has not able to contribute like it usually does to support Catholic education. Additionally, the pandemic has increased our school and AELC personnel costs and incurred other COVID-19 required safety expenses. At some point this year, the decreased income and increased expenses will deplete our savings, thus returning us to where we were in 2014. It could even result in drastic cuts to parish ministries, grade school and/or AELC.

**The good news** is that a number of our loyal Assumption donors have already donated over \$190,000 in "challenge gifts." They are challenging you to find a gift that you can afford to match with your own sacrificial gift. We are calling this campaign **#AssumptionTogether** because together we can get through this uncertain time!

I know you have had to deal with an unprecedented amount of uncertainty and upheaval this year, but this campaign is necessary for us to guarantee a vibrant future at Assumption. Thank you for all the many sacrifices you make for the children and for Assumption.


