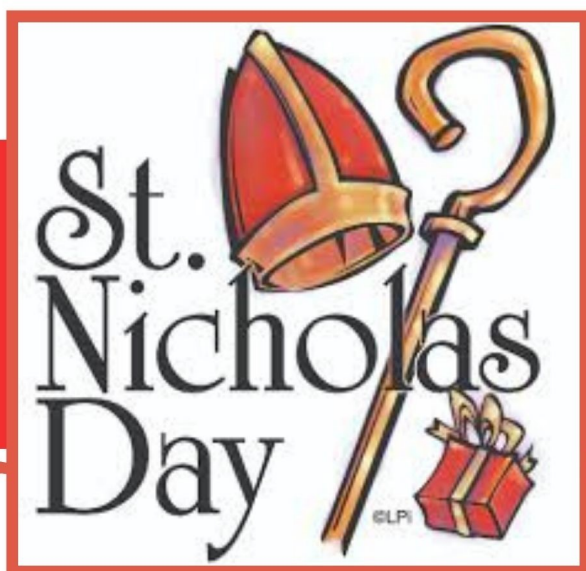
### Pro-Life Christmas Cards

*A new way to purchase gift cards online that will benefit Assumption Parish School ShopwithScrip is the online program for purchasing over 400 online gift cards.*

Credit card—the cost to the buyer is 2.6%. Keep in mind the rewards of the credit card will still be earned while Assumption School will earn the rebate.

***ADVANTAGES of this program:***

Mobile App—Planning to do some remodeling, appliance purchasing, or lawnmower purchase? Try doing your price comparisons online or by visiting the stores, and then purchase a gift card for the store you want online as you are ready to check out. The gift cards are sent immediately to you. Use the mobile app “*RaiseRight Fundraising by ShopWithScrip*”. Using the app, a gift card can be purchased while standing in line to pay for the meal or item.

Secure—Gift cards can be stored in a phone or in your email. While a physical gift card can be lost or stolen, an online gift card has the advantage of remaining securely stored in your account on your phone or in your email.

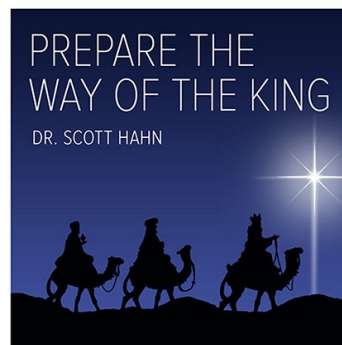
