

Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

Thanks

A sincere thanks to Mike Roberts for leading our Parish Mission! Thanks to Fran Ettling for providing music and Deacon Dave Schaefer for organizing the mission. It was a great success with participants both in-person and online.

Thanks to all of our Unstoppable Assumption Fish Fry Volunteers and to all who joined us last Friday. Last week, we served an incredible 1200 meals in just 2 ½ hours! We are continuing to tweak the Drive-Thru so join us again this week.

Holy Week

Last year's Holy Week and Easter were like none other as clergy around the world celebrated the most ancient and sacred Rites of the Church in isolation. But with the increasing volume of vaccinations, and rapidly falling number of positive COVID cases, this year's Holy Week should look more normal. We are planning to celebrate all our usual events publicly this year. However, some of the rituals will be changed, such as the omission of the Washing of the Feet on Holy Thursday, and we will Venerate the Cross from the pews on Good Friday. We will not have choirs yet, but since we have excellent musicians and cantors, we will plan on celebrating with the same joy as usual.

As of today, St. Louis County permits 50% occupancy for institutions like churches. So far this has not been a problem since many parishioners are still isolating. However, as Assumption parishioners are vaccinated, they are finally returning to Mass after a long and difficult year. So, if we begin to feel like we are reaching the occupancy level, and St. Louis County still prohibits larger gatherings, I will make changes to the Holy Week Schedule prior to Palm Sunday by adding additional liturgies in order to accommodate everyone who wants to attend. Stay tuned.

6:30 a.m., 8 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. daily Masses. After Wednesday, the daily Mass schedule is interrupted for the Sacred Triduum until Easter Sunday morning.

Spy Wednesday:

6-7p.m., Holy Hour and Confessions.

Holy Thursday:

7p.m., "Mass of the Lord's Supper" followed by adoration at the Altar of Repose until Midnight. Eucharistic Adorers should report to the church from 7 p.m. to midnight then public adoration is suspended from midnight until Midnight on Easter Sunday morning.

Good Friday:

Noon, Stations of the Cross.

Noon – 3 p.m., Confessions and "Tre Ore" Readings 3 p.m., Divine Mercy Chaplet.

4:30-7 p.m., Fish Fry (Drive-Thru & Pre-Order) 7 p.m., "Celebration of the Lord's Passion."




