



Personnel Changes

Another personnel change is coming to our staff. Cecilia Detwiler is behind our communications at Assumption. Cecilia also organizes programing for young adults and families with small children, the Lenten Challenge, and other great activities throughout the year. Cecilia will continue to work in these areas, but she is going to expand her scope of work to include Adult Faith Formation. Cecilia has amazing musical talents, and she is not shy to share her faith with others in small groups or before a large audience. As we begin emerging from Covid-land, Cecilia will help organize opportunities for adults of all ages at Assumption to share their faith. She will also help our Senior Ministry to come back to life, too, by working with the Senior Ministry Core Team and helping me begin some other initiatives for seniors.

Cemetery News

You may remember that we had the cemetery professionally surveyed and mapped a few years ago. When we did that, we had a "ground penetrating radar" identify empty graves in the oldest section of the cemetery. We compared these places to our records and discovered a number of places where we could sell additional graves. At the time, many parishioners opted to plan ahead and purchase those graves. As of now, it seems we have sold almost all of the full-sized graves.

We also took places where full-sized graves were not possible, and we plotted graves for cremains. There are still many cremain plots available. If you are interested in purchasing a cremain grave, please contact the parish office.

At some point, we may look for more full-sized grave locations, but it is possible that only those who have already purchased a grave will be able to be buried here in the future.

Confession

Every Catholic should make a good confession at least once a year, or as often as one falls into serious sin. Living in God's grace and being prepared to meet Him for our Final Judgement is as important as any other necessity in life. Fr Weber and I hear confessions on Wednesdays from 6-7 p.m., on Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. and 15 minutes prior to Sunday Masses. On Good Friday, we will hear confessions form Noon until 3 p.m.

You can support the Assumption Grade School and Early Learning Center through our new gift card program! You can order popular gift cards at ShopwithScrip.com.

There's TWO ways to pay:

<u>Checking account</u>—the cost is 15 cents for the entire transaction whether a \$10 card or a \$2,000 card is purchased. Less expensive than the cost of a check! Best deal is to purchase multiple cards at once. No extra charge. Fifteen cents for entire order.

<u>Credit card</u>—the cost to the buyer is 2.6%. Keep in mind the rewards of the credit card will still be earned while Assumption School will earn the rebate.

ADVANTAGES of this program:

Mobile App—Planning to do some remodeling, appliance purchasing, or lawnmower purchase? Try doing your price comparisons online or by visiting the stores, and then purchase a gift card for the store you want online as you are ready to check out. The gift cards are sent immediately to you. Use the mobile app "RaiseRight Fundraising by ShopWithScrip". Using the app, a gift card can be purchased while standing in line to pay for the meal or item.

<u>Secure</u>—Gift cards can be stored in a phone or in your email. While a physical gift card can be lost or stolen, an online gift card has the advantage of remaining securely stored in your account on your phone or in your email.
