

Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

Priest Transfers

As you have heard, Fr. Weber has been asked by Archbishop Rozanski to be the pastor at Good Shepherd Parish in Hillsboro, Missouri. This will be Fr. Weber's first assignment as pastor. We are proud and excited for him.




Fr. Weber has done a great job here at Assumption as our priest and assistant pastor. He has served as a dutiful confessor and homilist. He has been a constant presence at events in the parish. Fr. Weber has worked especially well with Assumption Youth Ministry, altar servers, Boy Scouts, grade school, and PSR students. He


has presided over the weddings and baptisms of parishioners. He has led individuals to deeper faith as they convert to Catholicism. He has been present in critical moments as dying parishioners have received sacraments from him. He has consoled families who have lost a loved one. As all priests, he has a ready heart to share Christ's love and grace to all.

In addition to his work here at Assumption, Fr. Weber has shown extraordinary courage as he took on the priest trained to offer Last Rites to dying COVID-19 patients at Mercy South. Fr. Weber also has been helping at the Archdiocesan Marriage Tribunal one day a week. And for several years, Fr. Weber has been the Catholic priest chaplain to the St. Louis Area Boy Scouts. I'm not sure what extra-parish responsibilities he might retain as pastor, but we are grateful for his work beyond Assumption too.

Fr. Weber was a joy to live with, I've enjoyed his quick sense of humor and he was always ready to help. He has been very patient, as I've often been away from the rectory at mealtimes to care for my mom. He also has been a great aid in my personal growth as I've developed the virtue of patience in accepting the utter chaos of the rectory kitchen. God have mercy on the kitchen in Hillsboro!

Fr. Weber's last weekend Mass will be the 10:30 a.m. September 19. We will have a little reception for him in the Church Lower Level after Mass. I hope everyone takes the opportunity to thank him for his priestly service here at Assumption.





After ordination, Fr. Buehler served as associate pastor at St. Francis Borgia in Washington, MO, and St. Paul in Fenton. He also served briefly as administrator at St. Ignatius in Marthasville. In 2019, he was named administrator and then the pastor at Good Shepherd, Hillsboro parish.

Occasionally, a priest discerns that serving in the role of pastor is not a good fit for him, so he requests to serve as an associate again. These priests are assigned with the title "senior associate." Fr. Buehler has chosen this path for now. When he arrives, Fr. Buehler will be responsible for all the regular associate duties at Assumption. I spoke to Fr. Buehler and he is looking forward to coming to Assumption!

Fr. Buehler will be moving in on September 21 or 22 and we will officially welcome him the following weekend.




