



Spiritual Adoption

Have you ever heard of *spiritual adoption*? "What is spiritual adoption?", you may ask. It is when a person pledges to pray for an unborn baby who is in danger of abortion. The Assumption Parish family will have the opportunity to "spiritually adopt" a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all newly conceived babies are given the opportunity to be born. In 2019, the CDC reported 629,898 abortions in the United States and an abortion ratio of 195 abortions per 1000 live births. It is these babies that you are being invited to "spiritually adopt". You may "adopt" a child individually or as a family by signing a pledge card. Pledge cards will be available next weekend in the pews and in the church foyers for you to take home. Our parish spiritual adoption program will begin on March 25th, the Feast of the Annunciation, where the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she would give birth to Jesus, and end on December 25th, the day Jesus was born! Those who decide to "spiritually adopt" a child will pledge to pray for that child each day for the duration of nine months. This pledge includes a daily spiritual adoption prayer and other suggestions of prayers and works of mercy. Watch the bulletin for monthly reports describing your adopted baby's development. There are millions of unborn babies desperately in need of your prayers. Won't you please "spiritually adopt" one and share the love for life that God has given to each one of us? Thank you! Mission of Jonah Prayer Ministry

"To more fully awaken everyone to the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit and their importance in empowering the ministry of bringing Christ to others through team prayer with each other in the Parish or Archdiocese."

We are happy to announce that Assumption is joining the 34 St. Louis area parishes serving their congregation with the Jonah Ministry. Praying for each other is an excellent way to affirm each other's faith as a community, to let the Holy Spirit heal our hurts, and to open our eyes to being thankful for the truth and love in every situation that we experience.

What is Jonah Prayer Ministry?

Hopefully, we individually pray for each other, family members, friends, and the world. Jonah Prayer is based on a parish, community level of interceding, asking God for specific needs. Just as Jonah cried out to God in his time of distress, God longs for us to call upon Him in times of spiritual, emotional, and physical challenges. The Ministry involves stating, with faith in God's healing power, what your prayer needs are to 2-3 Ministers who will then pray for you, calling upon the Holy Spirit to guide them, and entrusting your needs to Jesus' healing powers. In summary, Jonah Prayer Ministry is another beautiful way that the Holy Spirit can have profound direct spiritual impact both in the parish community and in personal lives. Jonah Prayer Ministry is about being present to fellow parishioners through prayer and praying with expectant faith knowing God brings about transformation/healing/growth.

Who are Jonah Prayer Ministers?

Jonah Prayer Ministers are people like yourself who are approved by the pastor for this ministry. The Ministry Team is comprised of Archdiocesan trained Jonah Prayer Ministers from Assumption who have felt called to pray for others and have the desire to use their spiritual gifts given by the Holy Spirit. Do I have to sign up? Not necessary, just approach the prayer teams directly after Mass. There will be a person to direct you to a group of Ministers.

Absolutely, confidentiality is one of the main principles of this Ministry. No information is shared about the person being prayed with and a level of quiet is requested.

Is there a cost? There is no cost. Your powerful prayer for the continuation of this Ministry would be helpful and appreciated.
