Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

Considering the recent event on March 25th, where Pope Francis, together with the bishops of the world, solemnly consecrated Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, several parishioners asked me to reiterate Our Lady of Fatima's request to all Catholics. They are simple actions that Catholics of all ages can do. These prayers are simple, they open our hearts to God's grace, and they help us pray for the world.

Our Lady asks us to begin each day with a Morning Offering:

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary,
I offer you my prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of this day
for all the intentions of your Sacred Heart
in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world,
for the salvation of souls, the reparation of sins, conversion of sinners, the reunion of all
Christians, and in particular for the intentions of the Holy Father. Amen.

Our Lady asks us to pray the Rosary daily, especially for the intention of world peace.

She asks us to <u>consecrate ourselves</u> to her Immaculate Heart and to wear the <u>Brown Scapular</u> of Our Lady of Mount Carmel as a sign of our personal consecration. Here is one of many examples of personal consecrations to the Immaculate Heart:

Blessed Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, I renew my consecration to you and to your Immaculate Heart. Please accept me, my dear Mother, and use me as you wish to accomplish your designs upon the world. I am all yours, my Mother, my Queen, and all that I have is yours.

Amen.

Finally, Our Lady asks that we go to confession and receive Holy Communion on the <u>First Saturday of the Month</u>. Confession can be 8 days before or after the First Saturday. Holy Communion is usually satisfied by the morning Mass on Saturday but could be at any Mass that day.

I encourage everyone to incorporate these and other beautiful Catholic devotions into your daily routine. We believe our prayers can change the world and certainly there is a great need!



Funeral Luncheon Ministry

We are preparing to offer funeral luncheons again!

To be a part of this parish outreach ministry, complete the form below and return it to the parish office/collection basket or go online at <u>assumptionstl.org/funeral-luncheon</u>.

Team Captains

Funeral luncheons are assigned to teams, each with a Team Captain. When a funeral is assigned to a team, the Captain notifies Callers of the dishes needed, schedules Servers for the luncheon, and guides the team in setup, serving, and cleanup on the day of the luncheon.

Callers

Callers are provided with a list of volunteers who have offered to provide dishes for funeral luncheons. Callers contact those volunteers and arrange for the dishes needed for the luncheon.

Servers

Serves the day of the funeral luncheon, accepting dishes from Food Providers, setting up for the luncheon, preparing drinks, and assisting with cleanup.

Food Providers

Food Providers prepare (or buy) a dish that will serve 10-12 people at the luncheon. Here's your chance to prepare and share your specialty dish!

Dishes needed include:

Dessert: cakes, pies, brownies, cupcakes, cookies, etc.

Vegetable/Casserole: potato casserole, green bean casserole, baked beans, pasta, etc.

Salad Ingredients: lettuce, dressing, croutons, shredded cheese, etc.

For planning purposes, we ask that you provide the same dish each time.

Frequently Asked Questions

When/Where do I drop off my dish?

Between 6:30-10:00 a.m. on the morning of the luncheon in the church basement kitchen.

What if I can't provide food on the day requested? Not a problem! We will call again the next time.

If I volunteered in the past, do I still need to sign up? Yes! Please sign up again so that we have current contact information.


