Pastor's Column

Congratulations to our **First Communicants and Confirmandi**! We pray that God continues to pour out His Divine Grace into their hearts, and as they grow in the Catholic Faith, that they invite others to join them on this journey to Heaven!

Monday, May 30, Memorial Day is a special day at Assumption. We have one Mass that day at 9 a.m. where we thank God for all those who serve in our nation's armed forces, and we pray for all those who have died as a result of their service. At the end of Mass, our Scouts lead a ceremony by the flagpole to remember those who died in service.

The Saturday, June 4 Assumption Summer Barbeque IS essentially the same as the Parish Picnic. The name change reflects that it starts later in the afternoon and there are no carnival rides this year. Both are effects of covidland. Everyone is welcome to the Summer BBQ, last year it was a great parish family event. The food was great, the music was fun, and the fireworks were amazing. It will be just as awesome this year!

Every Catholic should encourage and support vocations to the priesthood! The Vocation Office has a summer camp called **Kenrick Glennon Days.** It gives young men an opportunity to get to know seminarians and young priests while having a ton of fun with other young men from around the archdiocese. 6th and 7th graders – June 13-15 and 8th and 9th graders – June 16-18. 
At the same time!!! June 13-17, Assumption has **Totus Tuus Missionaries** coming to lead a week-long summer camp for all 1st -6th graders here on campus. Totus Tuus is a faith-based camp with lots of fun and excitement. Go to <u>assumptionstl.org</u> to find out more.

Needed: Assumption Shuttle Drivers – One of the unique ministries is the Assumption Shuttle. Very few Catholic parishes have such a great resource, but it is only as good as our drivers. Now that seniors are becoming active again after Covidland, some depend on this service to attend Sunday Mass and other parish events. Drivers do not need a special license or insurance. We have training for all drivers, and they can let us know when they are available.

Needed: Funeral Luncheons – One of the Corporal Works of Mercy is to "bury the dead." We participate in this work of mercy at Assumption by providing a meal for grieving families. Volunteers can choose from a number of options to help. We usually have one or two funerals a month that take advantage of the luncheon option.

Needed: Music Ministers – Our adult choir and children's choir are back in action! Many of our previous members have returned, but we are always looking for new cantors and choir members. If God gave you a gift of a beautiful voice, please use it for His worship. Sometimes, Catholic parishes have a culture where ladies feel more comfortable singing, but we need men and young men cantors and choir members too. St. Jerome said the basilicas of Rome thundered with singing. The clue "thundered" means that in the Early Church, men fully participated in the liturgical singing!


2022 Annual Catholic Appeal


