LIVING WITH LOSS: Widow/Widower Support Group



Assumption Pro-Life Ministry: Good Works

Our parish is active in several pro-life initiatives throughout the year. One of many highlights this past year was our participation in an effort to replace an outdated ultrasound machine at the Pregnancy Help Center located right here in South County.

Each October during pro-life month, Fr. Keller supports a focused fundraising appeal designed to finance efforts such as sending our schoolchildren to the March for Life in Washington D.C. However, the financial generosity of Assumption parishioners also allows parish outreach to local pro-life organizations.

The members of the Assumption Pro-Life Foundation have financially supported our local Pregnancy Help Center (PHC) for many years. This past year however, we were also interested in supporting any special project that PHC might identify. Ramona Davis, Director of PHC, commented that their existing ultrasound machine needed maintenance and that maybe Assumption could help with that bill. As the conversation progressed, it was noted that the existing machine was almost ten years old, and that newer and better technology was available.

The obstacle was the cost: \$27,000 for a new machine.

Since an ultrasound image of a baby in-utero is often a key factor in parents choosing life, the Assumption pro-life group decided to pursue this option, even though the \$27,000 price tag was much more than our parish could finance alone.

Tim Hessel of Assumption presented this need to the Knights of Columbus/Fr. Griffin Council. As the project progressed, Tim and other Knights found that matching funds were available from the K of C Supreme Council. Therefore, the focus became raising the first \$13,500. The Assumption pro-life group committed \$2500 to the project and then funding came forth from other local parishes: St. Catherine Laboure, Our Lady of Providence, Queen of All Saints, Sacred Heart Valley Park, and St. Simon.

The final outcome was that the team efforts of South County parishes resulted in raising the needed \$13,500 and that amount was then matched by the K of C Supreme Council.

The new ultrasound machine was delivered to PHC in April and placed into service in May. Pregnancy Help Center is located on Crescent Drive, adjacent to South County Mall (www. thepregnancyhelpcenter.com).


