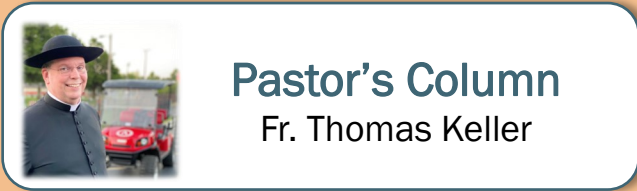

We will have one Mass to celebrate our American Independence on July 4 at 9:00 a.m. (no 6:30 a.m. or 8:00 a.m.) Join us to give God thanks for the blessings poured out on our nation. Note that the parish office will be closed for the holiday.

Church Parking Lot closed July 5-7

The main parking lot in front of the church, school, and rectory will be closed July 5–7 for repairs and resealing. Please use the Basler Lane entrance, park on the back lots, and use side doors to enter the church for morning Masses. The school building will be closed for the week of July 4. Good luck trying to get to the rectory.

Tax Credits

Tax Credits are available for donations to the Archdiocese Today and Tomorrow Education Foundation. Today and Tomorrow supports families who desire Catholic education for their children but have limited financial means.

The law provides state tax credits for contributions to approved, non-profit Educational Assistance Organizations, including The Today and Tomorrow Educational Foundation (TTEF). They will use the contributions to award scholarships to eligible Missouri students. Some of our current and prospective students will meet eligibility requirements and may apply for the MOScholars scholarships. This means that starting July 1, 2022, TTEF may receive qualified contributions from individuals and businesses to establish scholarship accounts for qualified Missouri students. 100% Missouri Tax-Credits are available for eligible donations and can be used for 50% of the donor's Missouri tax liability. This is a tremendous opportunity to provide significant support to students in Catholic schools at zero net cost to donors!

Information for Donors

TTEF and MOScholars Tax Credits

FAQs

What is the annual tax credit cap amount?

For 2022, \$25 million in MOScholars tax credits are available.

Who can donate?

Eligible donors to the MOScholars program include any of the following that files a Missouri income tax return and is not a dependent of any other taxpayer:

- An individual subject to state income tax;
- An individual, firm, partner in a firm, corporation or shareholder in an S-Corp doing business in the state and subject to state income tax; and,
- An express company that pays an annual tax on its gross receipts in Missouri under chapter 153.

What types of donations are eligible?

Eligible contributions are monetary donations of \$500 or more, including:

- Checks drawn on a US banking institution
- Money orders
- Electronic funds transfers

Today and Tomorrow Educational Foundation and MOScholars Tax Credits

About the Program

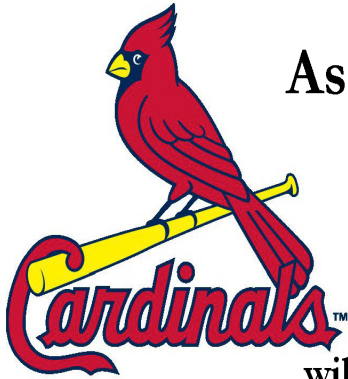
Starting **July 1, 2022**, donors of the Today and Tomorrow Educational Foundation (TTEF) are eligible to receive Missouri tax credits for contributions to the MOScholars program. These contributions provide scholarships to eligible low income students and those with Individual Education Plans (IEPs).

About the Tax Credits

A MOScholars tax credit is equal to 100% of an eligible donation, not to exceed 50% of the donor's state tax liability for the tax year the credit is claimed. MOScholars tax credits may be carried forward for four (4) subsequent tax years. The tax credit is not sellable, transferrable, or refundable.

How it Works

- Donors will apply to reserve tax credits through the Missouri State Treasurer's Office – MOScholars online system, then make a contribution to TTEF.
- Donations will be accepted beginning **July 1, 2022**.
- The contribution will be used to fund specified scholarships. The donor will receive a tax credit that can be used to offset their Missouri tax liability under sections 143 and 153.
- TTEF, as your Educational Assistance Organization, is responsible for accepting eligible donor contributions and submitting supporting documentation from eligible donors.

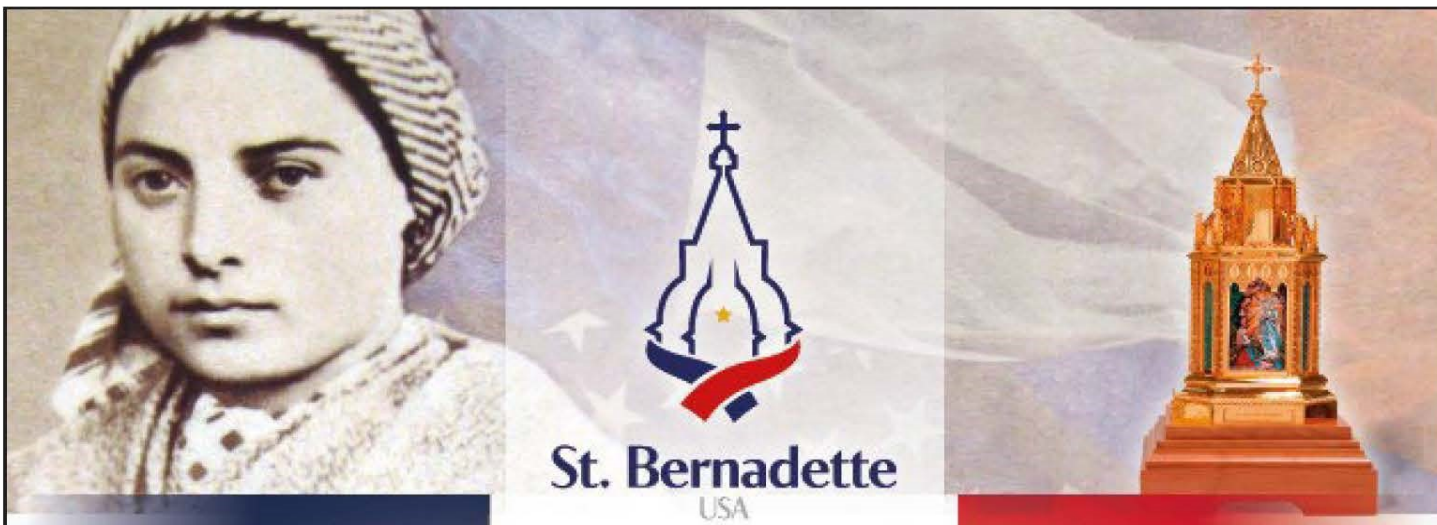

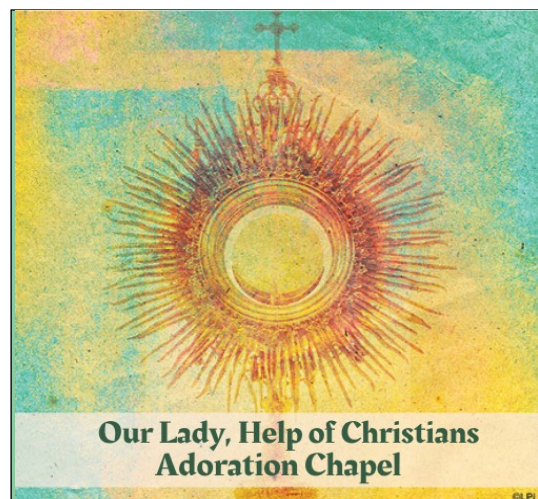
