



Feast of the Assumption

This year, August 15th is on a Monday. That means in the Archdiocese of St. Louis, the Solemnity of the Assumption is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation. As a parish, we will celebrate the feast on the previous Sunday, August 14. Everyone with a school-aged child (pre-school – high school) is invited to attend our 10:30 a.m. Mass for the Blessing of Students at the Beginning of an Academic Year (often called "Bless the Backpacks"). Following the 10:30 a.m. and Noon Masses, we will host "Feast on the Feast Day" with food trucks on the church parking lot near the Salesian House. Everyone is welcome to participate in the solemnity and fun!

Welcome Anna Hussey

Anna Hussey recently joined our parish staff as our new Middle School Youth Minister. She will be working with Caitlyn Sextro, our Youth Minister, to provide experiences of faith and fellowship for that demographic which is most at risk of falling away from the Church. Middle school students today need someone who they can turn to as an example and mentor in the faith as they begin the journey to adulthood. Today, many adolescents are defining their beliefs and values at an even younger age, and providing them with someone to turn to is an important part of our parish ministry.

Assumption at the Steubenville Youth Conference

Assumption Parish is always well represented at the annual Steubenville Youth Conference in Springfield, Missouri. The conference is jointly produced by the Archdiocese of St. Louis Office of Youth Ministry and Franciscan University of Steubenville. It is an energy-packed weekend with speakers who witness about loving Christ and the Catholic faith, Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, and the opportunity for Confession. Parishes can sign up for one of two weekends in July. Parishes bring teens from all over the Midwest. Assumption always sends a large group of 20-30 teens to the conference, along with the AYM core team and some parents to act as chaperones. Each year, several Assumption parishioners also volunteer to serve in several different capacities. Thanks to all the Assumption teens and adults who participated in this year's conference!

Math, Religion, Spanish, Music teacher

We have had some applicants, but we are still accepting applications for a middle school math teacher or middle school religion. (We currently have a teacher who can teach math or religion so we will adjust based on the applicant). We also are looking for a Spanish teacher and a music teacher. If you know anyone who fits the position, send them our way!

Fraud Alert

The priests never email or text parishioners asking for personal favors, gift cards, or any other gifts. Do not respond to requests from someone identifying themself as a priest and who asks for something unusual. Normally, the fraud includes an urgent need for gift cards. If the priest has time to email or text you, he has time to go online and get it himself.

Exactly how the perpetrators are getting information is not 100% clear since some parishioners have been emailed or texted, however the priests do not possess their contact information on their own devices. Regardless, do not respond to requests.
