

Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

Rest in peace

We have many very dedicated parishioners and unfortunately, every so often we lose one to death. Although all of them should be remembered, especially in prayer, sometimes we lose one that we must publicly acknowledge because of the impact they have had on the parish. This week we lost Joanna May. She died on the feast of the Assumption, which is very fitting since she loved this parish and dedicated herself to it.

Joanna was a very humble person who was always willing to work in the background. In fact, I think very few people, even her close friends, realize how important she was to the parish. She would volunteer here for many hours a week. She even had her own desk here, just like a staff member! Joanna helped with our St. Vincent de Paul Society, Senior Ministry, ACTS Retreats, RCIA, Adult Faith Formation, Auctions, Fish Frys, Parish Picnics, Homecomings, Funeral Luncheons, ProLife activities, and our school OASIS tutoring program to name a few! She edited newsletters for Assumption alumni. She was a lector at Mass. A few years ago, she received recognition from the Archdiocese for her outstanding service to Assumption.

In addition to volunteering, Joanna also generously supported the parish financially, but always under the agreement of anonymity, but now that she has passed away, I think we should publicly acknowledge her generosity. She was a leader in all our major parish and school capital campaigns and fundraisers. Also, every year, she helped multiple families with Grade School tuition. She supported St. Martha's Hall. And finally, I can say, after keeping this a secret for several years; one day she made an appointment with me to tell me how happy she was that we had started a Senior Ministry. She told me she wanted us to expand the program to help seniors with mobility issues get to Mass and other parish events. So, Joanna donated enough money for us to purchase a custom-built disabled-accessible vehicle that we now call the "Assumption Shuttle." Many parishioners have asked me where did we get the money for such a nice shuttle? Joanna is the answer.

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Joanna May, she loved the people of Assumption very much and everyone who knew her loved her too.




