Opportunities for Charity this Holiday Season

Assumption is a very generous parish. During the next few weeks there are multiple ways to express love from the heart and to share the many blessings we have received. Here's a brief overview of some ways you can get involved in our holiday season charities:

<u>Thanksgiving Day Food Drive</u> – Our St. Vincent de Paul Society collects nonperishable food donations for the parish food pantry or monetary donations to assist neighbors with utility needs. Donations are collected on Thanksgiving Morning at the 9am Mass.

<u>The Giving Tree</u> – Everyone loves grabbing ornaments with gift ideas off the "giving tree" and returning with those gifts the following weeks. Those items are then divided to assist families and individuals in need in the St. Louis area.

<u>Sponsor-A-Family</u> – Gift cards or cash donations in \$25 increments to support St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist parish families in North St. Louis and local families through our St. Vincent de Paul Society.

<u>Christmas in Prison Meal</u> – Some of our Assumption parishioners care for the spiritual needs of Catholic community at the Potosi Correctional Facility. Parishioners are invited to provide desserts or financial assistance to purchase the meal.

<u>Spiritual Adoption Celebration</u> – Nine months have passed since parishioners adopted unborn children in danger of abortion and daily prayed that they be born safely. Now we can show physical care by donating through Amazon Wish to help the Pregnancy Help Center of St. Louis.

Spiritual Adoption--8th Month We are almost done! The baby likes to listen to her mother's voice. The baby is also busy gaining weight and developing a layer of fat that will keep her warm after she is born. She is about 19 inches long and the size of a winter melon. In the ninth month, the baby's head will shift downwards, preparing for birth. Although some of her bones have begun to harden, her skull is still soft to allow it to pass more easily through the birth canal when the time comes. The baby might also be a little more active this month--stretching, kicking and hiccupping! The babies and mothers of this Spiritual Adoption program have benefitted from our prayers. Prayer is so powerful and so necessary!






