

Fasting: All Catholics ages 18-59 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (Fasting means one full meal, two smaller meals, refraining from meat, and nothing between meals except liquids.)

Abstinence: All Catholics ages 14 and up must abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent.
