

Pastor's Column

Fr. Thomas Keller

Many years ago, the city of Rome had been inflicted with a terrible plague. Thousands of people died. Everyone knew someone who died of the plague. Gravediggers could not keep up with the need. Everything in the city was closed because people were afraid to go outside or to open their businesses. The pope at the time was Gregory the Great. He decided the only remedy was to implore heaven for help. So, he organized a religious procession through the streets of Rome.

Despite the great fear of disease, thousands of people turned out to pray. The clergy of Rome led the procession, and they carried a treasured painting of the Blessed Virgin. As they were crossing a bridge over the Tiber River, the people heard angels singing near the image of Mary. They heard the angels sing, "Rejoice, Queen of Heaven! The Son you merited to bear has risen as He said, Alleluia." Then Pope Gregory looked up and saw an angel sheathing a bloody sword. Gregory knew their prayers were answered and the plague was over. The pope had the simple words of the heavenly song recorded and then he promptly added a final line, "Pray to God for us. Alleluia."

The song lyrics tell a beautiful story. Early in the morning on the third day after Jesus died, angels were sent from heaven to His sorrowful mother, Mary. The angels encouraged Mary not to be sad but to rejoice because her Son had risen from the dead!

However, the song had a personal meaning to the people of Rome. The plague was terrifying, but more so, they were all disheartened from grieving over loved ones who died. But the angels' song inviting Mary to rejoice because Jesus had risen from the dead, reminded the mournful people of Rome that Christ promised eternal life to all who believe, and they were filled with profound joy.

The song the people learned from the angels is known as the Regina Caeli. It became an Easter Hymn and is often sung at the conclusion of the Easter Sunday Mass. Even today, between Easter and Pentecost, priests, deacons, and religious men and women also recite the hymn right before they go to bed. It is a reminder that just as we anticipate rising from the bed the next day, we anticipate someday rising from the dead with Christ.

Queen of Heaven rejoice, alleluia. The Son you merited to bear, alleluia, Has risen as He said, alleluia. Pray to God for us, alleluia.

Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia, For the Lord has truly risen! Alleluia!

Let us pray, O God, Who gave joy to the world through the Resurrection of your Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech you, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of Everlasting Life. Through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.




