Congratulations

Fr. Buehler's 10th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood is coming up! To thank God and to celebrate his commitment to priestly ministry we will have a special Noon Mass on June 4 followed by a light luncheon in the Church Lower Level. Parishioners are invited to attend! We will be joined by some of Fr. Buehler's family as well as friends from religious communities and from previous parish assignments.

As one of the steps toward ordination to the Permanent Diaconate, Jeremy Remiger was installed as an acolyte at a ceremony last Thursday. God willing, Jeremy will be ordained a deacon next spring. Please keep Jeremy in your prayers.

Two Kenrick seminarians who served here at Assumption on the weekends and with our youth group were ordained to the Transitional Diaconate last week. Deacon Joseph Martin and Deacon Rob Lawson are in their last year of preparation for the priesthood. Please keep them in your prayers.

All Things New Update

Recently an insightful parishioner asked if Assumption would be required to share ministries with other parishes as a result of the All Things New strategic planning process?

Assumption already shares a number of ministries with other parishes. We share a Knights of Columbus Council with Seven Holy Founders in Affton and Our Lady of Providence in Crestwood. Our ACTS Retreats collaborate with St. John the Beloved Disciple parish in Shady Grove. Our Young Adult Ministry included St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Francis of Assisi, and Queen of All Saints. We were developing joint activities for ladies and seniors with St. Nicholas Parish in the North City Deanery prior to Covid but they asked to put it on hold until after All Things New. Finally, we share our campus with the St. Martha drop-in center for women and children who have experienced domestic abuse. As you can see, the parishioners of Assumption have been very open to collaborations and welcoming to parishioners from other places.

Currently, the All Things New process is focusing on smaller parishes that can share clergy, particularly a pastor. Announcements regarding groupings of parishes sharing a single pastor will be announced on May 28 and will be implemented by August 1.

However, there will be more schools, PSR programs, youth and senior ministries collaborating in the future. The expense of maintaining all these ministries at one site can be prohibitive. While each parish is a special home for parishioners, it is reasonable to believe there will be more shared programming in the future. Although, at this time, it is impossible to predict how shared resources will be developed.

Archbishop Rozanski recently announced that the archdiocese would be divided into three "vicariates." A vicariate is a geographic area under the oversight of a priest who has been named an Episcopal Vicar. Each Episcopal Vicar will have staff who will be resources to the pastors of the area. They will likely be part of discussions with parishes who need shared resources in the future.


