

Looking for Teachers

Our Grade School needs additional teachers and aides. It will be difficult for us to move personnel around to meet the students' needs in the Fall. Most importantly, we are looking for a middle school Math teacher and an English Language Arts teacher. We are also looking for a Spanish teacher and classroom aides. Spread the word that Assumption is a great place to work!

Drivers Needed

Our Assumption Shuttle is one of our hidden treasures at Assumption. We use it to bring parishioners to the 10:30 Mass each Sunday as well as other parish events. We need additional drivers! You need not have a special driver's license, and the shuttle is covered by parish insurance. All new drivers receive a thorough orientation and training on the shuttle. Contact the parish office if you can help once a month.

Knights of Columbus

Men of the parish, consider membership in the Knights of Columbus. They meet monthly and are dedicated to supporting the Church through prayer, family life and acts of charity. Lots of men associate the Knights with ceremonial hats, capes, and swords, but only a small number of Knights serve in the honor guard, most are involved in the everyday work of the Order. The Knights are indispensable to parish life, supporting a number of activities and providing volunteers for important events. The Knights of Columbus also provide insurance and investment opportunities to the families of individual Knights in the event of their passing so they will be cared for. If you are interested in becoming a Knight of Columbus, contact our parish office and we will get you in touch with them.

Pro-Life Foundation

Assumption has a group of parishioners who make a specific annual donation to a reserved fund known as the "Pro-Life Foundation." The foundation is managed by a committee who distributes the contributions to local Pro-Life organizations. These organizations focus their attention on direct care of mothers who are at-risk for an abortion and they help them find sustainable assistance so they can raise their child. Often Pro-Abortion advocates accuse the Pro-Life movement of not helping mothers. Of course, this is a lie, along with so many other lies Pro-Abortionists tell. I am very proud of the work of our Assumption Pro-Life Foundation. Each year the members of the foundation are welcome to a meal together and a speaker from one of the organizations they support shares their success stories. I recommend, if you are looking for a charity to support, the Assumption Pro-Life Foundation does good work.

Adoration Chapel

We are always looking for individuals who are willing to make the sacrifice of one hour a week to pray before the Blessed Sacrament in our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. The chapel is large enough to accommodate multiple individuals at once, but we do not want to leave the Blessed Sacrament unattended. If you used to be an Adorer but dropped out during Covid or lost that initial zeal and quit after a period of time, now is a great time to make that commitment again and return. Adorers are asked to make one Holy Hour a week. The time is up to you. You can commit any time of day or night. Adorers usually pray the Rosary, bring or borrow spiritual reading from our little chapel library or they spend time in silent adoration and prayer. If you have never been an Adorer and would like to try, contact the parish office and we can help get you started.

Summer Inside Catholicism


Explore what it means to love God and what the Sacred Heart means today. This devotion has developed in recent decades, and it offers new ways to enter in to the love of God.






