Partners in Education

Each year, we ask parishioners and school families to participate in the Partners in Education campaign. This helps us provide Catholic education to any family, especially those in need, but it also helps us fund special benefits for teachers and staff and it supports education for all our students. It is very important all parishioners consider making a special sacrificial gift to help Catholic education here at Assumption. In the past, Assumption parishioners have been very supportive of Partners in Education, and we hope parishioners continue to support our school and AELC. I will be reaching out to everyone to ask for your support in the next few weeks. Thank you for your generosity!

Job Openings

As the 2023-2024 school year approaches, Assumption Grade School and Early Learning Center have critical positions to fill. We need the help of all parishioners to get the word out to potential candidates! We are posting job openings on the Internet too. If you are on social media and see one of our posts, please share it.

Aftercare workers – Adults to help supervise the children after 2:45 p.m. We accept applications as young as 18 (sometimes 16 & 17 if they are responsible young people).

Director of the Early Learning Center – This needs to be a person with considerable childcare experience and education who can manage faculty, staff, budget, and facilities, as well as cooperate with the grade school with shared space. Student development, safety, and staff supervision are key areas of responsibility.

Early Learning Center teachers – we are looking for multiple AELC teachers for children ages infant to toddler.

Math Teacher and **Math Aide** for the middle school (grades 6, 7, & 8).

Spanish Teacher for preschool through 8th grade. This is a part-time position for someone who is fluent in Spanish.

Parish Director of Youth Ministry – A person with a deep faith a profound joy and the ability to communicate discipleship to young people.




