(Two of our grades are split into two classrooms due to larger enrollment). Remember a few years ago we dedicated 5 classrooms to the AELC so there are fewer classrooms available for the grade school. But that is okay because as long as the existing classrooms are full and the AELC continues to feed the kindergarten, the school will remain stable into the future.

Good News!

Thanks to everyone who helped us find new employees! We plan on announcing the names of a new AELC Director, and Director of Youth Ministry soon. We also have a new Math teacher and several new Aftercare staff members. There are still a few more positions we are looking for, but we have made great progress with everyone's prayers and help!

Future Holiday Mass Schedule:

Starting on Labor Day we are going to adjust our civic holiday Mass schedule. Starting on this upcoming Labor Day and in the future on Memorial Day and Independence Day we will follow our normal 6:30 and 8:00 a.m. Mass schedule. We will have music at the 8:00 a.m. to celebrate the holiday. The only exception will be Thanksgiving Day when we will maintain the 9:00 a.m. Mass followed by our Parish Thanksgiving Brunch. Our Holy Day of Obligation Mass schedules will remain the same.

Prison Ministry

Don't forget to drop off yarn for the inmates at the Potosi Correctional Center. They make hats, blankets and more for newborns as a way to give back to society. We will accept yarn for three more weeks.

Retreat opportunity



Women's ACTS Retreat October 5-8



An ACTS retreat allows each retreatant to focus on her faith and how it applies in daily life, to increase purpose in her prayer life, to experience the love of God through others, and to build a stronger faith community.

The retreat begins Thursday evening October 5, with check-in between 6:00-6:15 p.m. at Assumption Church. Transportation to and from the Marianist Retreat Center in Eureka, Missouri, is provided. The retreat concludes Sunday, October 8, after the 10:30 a.m. Mass at Assumption, with a gathering following in the church lower level.

Accommodations for retreatants include a private room and bath at Marianist. Cost for each retreatant is \$275. A deposit of \$75 is payable with your registration, and the remaining \$200 is payable any time before, or at check-in for the retreat on October 5.


