Eucharistic Procession and Adoration

On Sunday evening, after the 6 p.m. Mass, we will have a Candlelight Procession with the Most Blessed Sacrament followed by a period of adoration "under the stars." Everyone is invited to join us around 7 p.m. We will provide candles, praise and worship music, time for silent adoration, and confessions will be available. You may want to bring a lawn chair to sit on or a blanket to use when kneeling. Dress warmly if it is chilly out. The ceremony will end with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament around 8 p.m.

Partners in Education

School and ELC Staffing

We have been quietly holding our breath because something unexpected could always go wrong, but... drumroll please! We are currently fully staffed at the grade school! Holy Land Pilgrimages

As I think everyone knows, I promised a pilgrimage to the Holy Land way back in 2018. The first dates were cancelled due to Covid, then we rescheduled for November. Then the response was so overwhelming we added a second pilgrimage in March. Now a major military conflict has broken out between the terrorist organizations HAMAS and the State of Israel. While the fighting is currently located in Gaza near Egypt, the West Bank, where several Christian Shrines, including Bethlehem, Jericho, and Bethany has been sealed off. Currently, we are hoping that it will be safe to go, but realistically we realize that it may not be feasible. Please keep the Christian families and clergy living in the Holy Land in your prayers.

Trees on Campus

You may have noticed we recently removed two big old trees. One by the exit to Mattis and the other behind the St. Martha's offices. They were quickly dying, and both were in areas where people could be injured by falling limbs. It's unfortunate that we had to remove them because our campus is greatly enhanced by all the beautiful landscaping. The good news is that we are planning on planting a number of new trees in the next few weeks. We hope another large tree will grow near the St. Martha's building and we are planting several new Missouri Redbuds and Dogwoods in the rectory and Basler Lane area.


Retiring American Flags


