## Pastor's Column

Fr. Thomas Keller



Above is a photo from last Sunday. It is of the Myanmar Catholic Community who celebrated Holy Mass here at Assumption for the first time. They have officially asked to make Assumption their new home.

Fr. Stephen En Suan Liam is a priest from Myanmar who has joined the Archdiocese of St. Louis. He is currently assigned with Fr. Michael Boehm and serves at Sacred Heart in Crystal City, Our Lady in Festus and Good Shepherd in Hillsboro. But, in addition to his regular duties, Fr. Stephen also celebrates weekend Masses for his fellow Catholics from Myanmar in the Zomi language. Members of the Myanmar Catholic Community live all over St. Louis but many of them live in or near the South County area, so Assumption is a great location for them.

I have been talking with Fr. Stephen about the best times for Mass and he suggested the first and thirdSaturdays at 7:30 p.m. and Sundays at 2:00 p.m. It will require a little work to make the schedule fit together perfectly. We will keep our First Communion in May, but we will need to cancel our annual Divine Mercy Sunday Holy Hour. The Living Rosary on the third Sunday of the month will move to 3:30 p.m. We will livestream the Sunday 2:00 p.m. Mass just like all the rest of the Masses. Otherwise, normally the church is available in the afternoon, so I think everything will work out.

The Myanmar families are very close to one another so after Mass they are accustomed to staying and socializing. They will also use our church lower level unless something is already scheduled. You may notice the large number of children in the photo, so they will love our fields and playground too. On holidays they like to spend the day together so after Mass, they will spend the rest of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter together here on campus celebrating as one family.

Everyone I met was extremely friendly and gracious, and even though language is a barrier (except the younger members) I hope that as time goes by, they will feel at home at Assumption, and we will be very proud to welcome this community into our greater Assumption parish family. The Myanmar Catholics will not be mere guests, Fr. Stephen will register the members of the community as official Assumption parishioners. They will support the parish and hopefully with time they will become involved in parish activities. Maybe in the future we can have an event together so we can all meet each other.
