We have something special to celebrate – Assumption-Mattese Grade School is the LONGEST continuously operating Catholic Parochial School in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Yeah, I'm looking at you historic Ste. Genevieve, what are you going to do about it, huh? Assumption Pastor, Fr. Simon Sigrist founded a one-room school house here in 1848. Since then, thousands of children have received a Catholic education at Assumption over the years. Think of all the contributions to society and the souls in heaven due to the foundation laid by the religious men and women and lay Catholic educators at Assumption.

We are beginning Catholic Schools Week with an open house for parishioners and prospective students and their families today from 10a.m. to 1p.m. We will have all-school Masses every day and the students will have fun special activities throughout the week finally culminating in the exciting 8th grade verses faculty volleyball game. Thanks to all our creative live and silent auction donors. The live auction packages and the silent auction items were exciting and it seems very much in demand. Thanks to our many generous sponsors. Sponsors make events like this possible. We have named them in previous bulletins, please patronize their businesses.

Special thanks to everyone who attended. It was great to see multi-generational support for the parish. School parents and seniors mingled together. Everyone's willingness to come together, have fun, and generously support Assumption made the night a huge success! Before expenses, it looks like we raised around \$160,000. That's not possible without dedicated leadership, volunteers and participants. The profit from the auction goes toward a number of important things at Assumption including parish activities and school operations.

Thanks to everyone who donated to our Fund-a-Need. The Fund-a-Need component of the auction supported a plan to replace the school and parish center fire control panel and the PA (public address intercom) with a state-of-the-art integrated emergency communication system which we plan to extend throughout the campus. It's estimated that this will cost \$150,000. Fund-a-Need donations raised over \$50,000 toward that goal!

Everyone seemed to enjoy the new venue. We had used the Parish Center in the past but moving to the Royal Orleans on Telegraph Road cut down on volunteer labor. Everyone seemed to think the location added to the festive atmosphere. The folks at the Royal Orleans were easy to work with. Thankfully the weather cooperated too. It was cold but we avoided snow and ice.




